Conjugate Conditionate

Conditionate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I conditionate
You conditionate
He/She/It conditionates They conditionate

Conditionate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am conditionating We are conditionating
You are conditionating You are conditionating
He/She/It is conditionating They are conditionating

Conditionate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have conditionated We have conditionated You have conditionated He/She/It has conditionated They have conditionated

Conditionate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been conditionating
You have been conditionating
He/She/It has been conditionating
They have been conditionating

Conditionate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I conditionated We conditionated
You conditionated You conditionated
He/She/It conditionated They conditionated

Conditionate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was conditionating We were conditionating
You were conditionating You were conditionating
He/She/It was conditionating They were conditionating

Conditionate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had conditionated We had conditionated
You had conditionated You had conditionated
He/She/It had conditionated They had conditionated

Conditionate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been conditionating
You had been conditionating
He/She/It had been conditionating
They had been conditionating

Conditionate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will conditionate
You will conditionate
He/She/It will conditionate
They will conditionate

Conditionate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be conditionating
You will be conditionating
He/She/It will be conditionating
They will be conditionating

Conditionate in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have conditionated We will have conditionated You will have conditionated He/She/It will have conditionated They will have conditionated

Conditionate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been conditionating
You will have been conditionating
He/She/It will have been conditionating
They will have been conditionating
