# **The Forms of Conduct**

Infinitive	to conduct
Present Tense	conduct / conducts
Past Tense	conducted
Present Participle	conducting
Past Participle	conducted

# **Conjugate Conduct**

## **Conduct in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I conduct	We <b>conduct</b>
You <b>conduct</b>	You <b>conduct</b>
He/She/It conducts	They conduct

## **Conduct in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am conducting	We <b>are conducting</b>
You are conducting	You are conducting
He/She/It is conducting	They are conducting

#### **Conduct in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have conducted	We have conducted
You have conducted	You have conducted
He/She/It has conducted	They have conducted

## **Conduct in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been conducting	We have been conducting
You have been conducting	You have been conducting
He/She/It has been conducting	They have been conducting

## **Conduct in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I conducted	We <b>conducted</b>
You <b>conducted</b>	You <b>conducted</b>
He/She/It conducted	They <b>conducted</b>

#### **Conduct in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was conducting	We were conducting
You were conducting	You were conducting
He/She/It was conducting	They were conducting

#### **Conduct in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had conducted	We had conducted
You had conducted	You had conducted
He/She/It had conducted	They had conducted

## **Conduct in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been conducting	We had been conducting
You <b>had been conducting</b>	You had been conducting
He/She/It had been conducting	They had been conducting

## **Conduct in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will conduct	We will conduct
You will conduct	You will conduct
He/She/It will conduct	They will conduct

## **Conduct in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be conducting	We will be conducting
You <b>will be conducting</b>	You will be conducting
He/She/It will be conducting	They will be conducting

#### **Conduct in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have conductedWe will have conductedYou will have conductedYou will have conductedHe/She/It will have conductedThey will have conducted

#### **Conduct in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been conducting	We will have been conducting
You <b>will have been conducting</b>	You will have been conducting
He/She/It will have been conducting	They will have been conducting
