Present Tense	<b>conduct / conducts</b>
Past Tense	<b>conducted</b>
Present Participle	<b>conducting</b>
Past Participle	<b>conducted</b>

## Conjugate Conduct

### Conduct in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I conduct**

**We conduct**

**You conduct**

**You conduct**

**He/She/It conducts**

**They conduct**

## **Conduct in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I am conducting**

**We are conducting**

**You are conducting**

**You are conducting**

**He/She/It is conducting**

**They are conducting**

## **Conduct in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I have conducted**

**We have conducted**

**You have conducted**

**You have conducted**

**He/She/It has conducted**

**They have conducted**

## **Conduct in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I have been conducting**

**We have been conducting**

**You have been conducting**

**You have been conducting**

**He/She/It has been conducting**

**They have been conducting**

## **Conduct in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I conducted**

**We conducted**

**You conducted**

**You conducted**

**He/She/It conducted**

**They conducted**

## **Conduct in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I was conducting</b>	<b>We were conducting</b>
<b>You were conducting</b>	<b>You were conducting</b>
<b>He/She/It was conducting</b>	<b>They were conducting</b>

**Conduct in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had conducted</b>	<b>We had conducted</b>
<b>You had conducted</b>	<b>You had conducted</b>
<b>He/She/It had conducted</b>	<b>They had conducted</b>

**Conduct in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had been conducting</b>	<b>We had been conducting</b>
<b>You had been conducting</b>	<b>You had been conducting</b>
<b>He/She/It had been conducting</b>	<b>They had been conducting</b>

**Conduct in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I will conduct</b>	<b>We will conduct</b>
<b>You will conduct</b>	<b>You will conduct</b>
<b>He/She/It will conduct</b>	<b>They will conduct</b>

**Conduct in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I will be conducting</b>	<b>We will be conducting</b>
<b>You will be conducting</b>	<b>You will be conducting</b>
<b>He/She/It will be conducting</b>	<b>They will be conducting</b>

**Conduct in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have conducted**

**We will have conducted**

**You will have conducted**

**You will have conducted**

**He/She/It will have conducted**

**They will have conducted**

**Conduct in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been conducting**

**We will have been conducting**

**You will have been conducting**

**You will have been conducting**

**He/She/It will have been conducting**

**They will have been conducting**
