Present Tense	<b>cone / cones</b>
Past Tense	<b>coned</b>
Present Participle	<b>coning</b>
Past Participle	<b>coned</b>

## Conjugate Cone

**Cone in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>cone</b>	We <b>cone</b>
You <b>cone</b>	You <b>cone</b>
He/She/It <b>cones</b>	They <b>cone</b>

## **Cone in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am coning</b>	We <b>are coning</b>
You <b>are coning</b>	You <b>are coning</b>
He/She/It <b>is coning</b>	They <b>are coning</b>

## **Cone in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have coned</b>	We <b>have coned</b>
You <b>have coned</b>	You <b>have coned</b>
He/She/It <b>has coned</b>	They <b>have coned</b>

## **Cone in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been coning</b>	We <b>have been coning</b>
You <b>have been coning</b>	You <b>have been coning</b>
He/She/It <b>has been coning</b>	They <b>have been coning</b>

I <b>coned</b>	We <b>coned</b>
You <b>coned</b>	You <b>coned</b>
He/She/It <b>coned</b>	They <b>coned</b>

I <b>was coning</b>	We <b>were coning</b>
You <b>were coning</b>	You <b>were coning</b>
He/She/It <b>was coning</b>	They <b>were coning</b>

I <b>had coned</b>	We <b>had coned</b>
You <b>had coned</b>	You <b>had coned</b>
He/She/It <b>had coned</b>	They <b>had coned</b>

I <b>had been coning</b>	We <b>had been coning</b>
You <b>had been coning</b>	You <b>had been coning</b>
He/She/It <b>had been coning</b>	They <b>had been coning</b>

I <b>will be coning</b>	We <b>will be coning</b>
You <b>will be coning</b>	You <b>will be coning</b>
He/She/It <b>will be coning</b>	They <b>will be coning</b>

**I will have coned**

**We will have coned**

**You will have coned**

**You will have coned**

**He/She/It will have coned**

**They will have coned**

**I will have been coning**

**We will have been coning**

**You will have been coning**

**You will have been coning**

**He/She/It will have been coning**

**They will have been coning**
