Infinitive	to confection
Present Tense	confection / confections
Past Tense	confectioned
Present Participle	confectioning
Past Participle	confectioned

# **Conjugate Confection**

### **Confection in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I confection	We <b>confection</b>
You confection	You <b>confection</b>
He/She/It confections	They confection

### **Confection in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am confectioning	We are confectioning
You <b>are confectioning</b>	You are confectioning
He/She/It is confectioning	They are confectioning

#### **Confection in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have confectioned	We have confectioned
You have confectioned	You have confectioned
He/She/It has confectioned	They have confectioned

### **Confection in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been confectioning	We have been confectioning
You have been confectioning	You have been confectioning
He/She/It has been confectioning	They have been confectioning

### **Confection in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I confectioned	We <b>confectioned</b>
You <b>confectioned</b>	You <b>confectioned</b>
He/She/It confectioned	They <b>confectioned</b>

#### **Confection in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was confectioning	We were confectioning
You were confectioning	You were confectioning
He/She/It was confectioning	They were confectioning

#### **Confection in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had confectioned	We had confectioned
You had confectioned	You had confectioned
He/She/It had confectioned	They had confectioned

#### **Confection in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been confectioning	We had been confectioning
You had been confectioning	You had been confectioning
He/She/It had been confectioning	They had been confectioning

### **Confection in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will confection	We will confection
You will confection	You will confection
He/She/It will confection	They will confection

### **Confection in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be confectioning	We will be confectioning
You <b>will be confectioning</b>	You will be confectioning
He/She/It will be confectioning	They will be confectioning

### **Confection in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have confectionedWe will have confectionedYou will have confectionedYou will have confectionedHe/She/It will have confectionedThey will have confectioned

### **Confection in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been confectioning	We will have been confectioning
You <b>will have been confectioning</b>	You will have been confectioning
He/She/It will have been confectioning	They will have been confectioning
