According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “configuration” as a noun can have the following definitions:

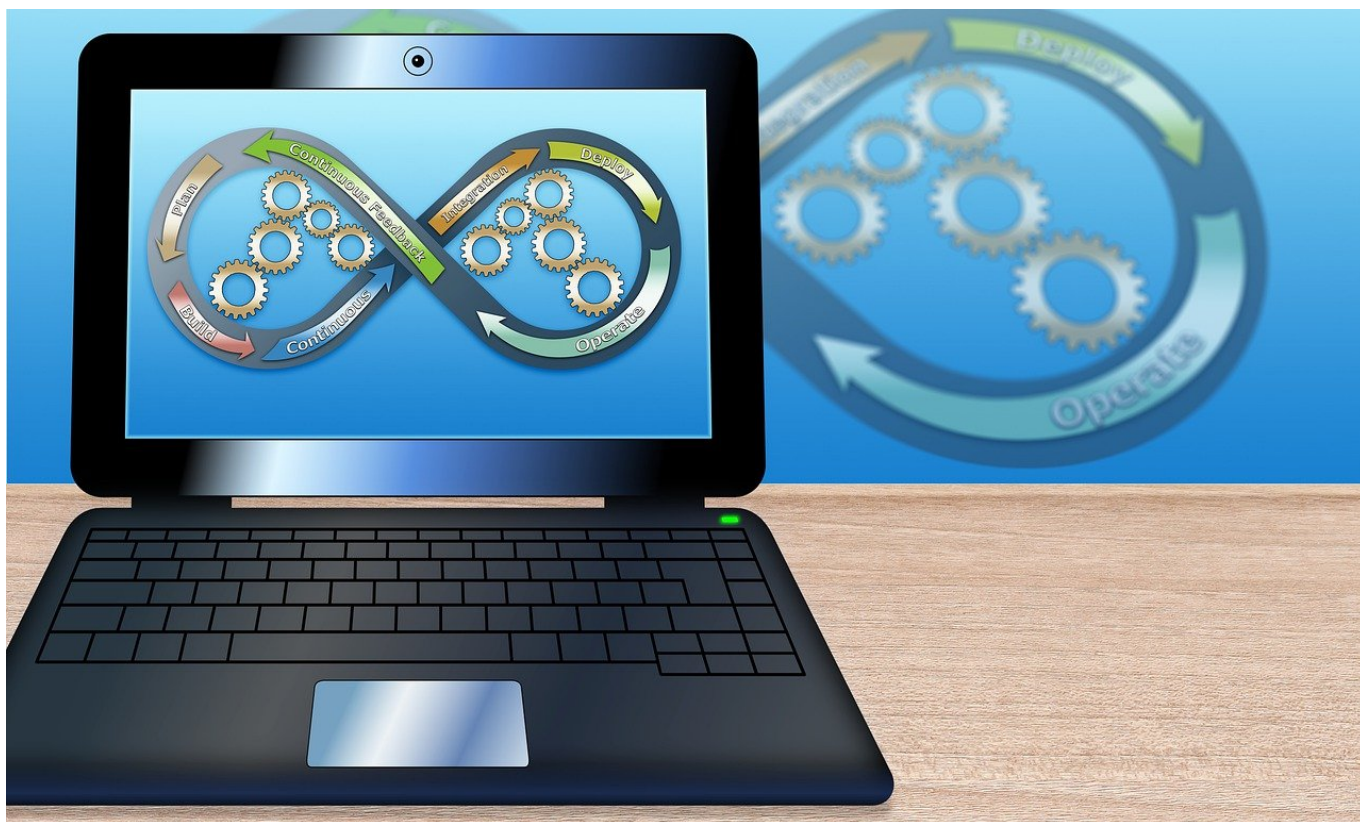
- *The fixed three-dimensional relationship of the atoms in a molecule, defined by the bonds between them.*

- *Any spatial attributes (especially as defined by outline).*

<u>geography</u>	(especially in business) a geographical area; a region. <i>The geography of post war London.</i>

grouping	The activity of putting things together in groups. <i>A grouping of left wing trade union leaders.</i>
layout	A thing arranged or set out in a particular way. <i>A model railway layout.</i>
order	A thing made supplied or served as a result of an order. <i>The skipper gave the order to abandon ship.</i>
ordering	Logical or comprehensible arrangement of separate elements. <i>There were mistakes in the ordering of items on the list.</i>
organization	The act of organizing a business or an activity related to a business. <i>He was brought in to supervise the organization of a new department.</i>
positioning	The post or function properly or customarily occupied or served by another.
presentation	A visual representation of something. <i>The presentation of foods is designed to stimulate your appetite.</i>
ranging	A large tract of grassy open land on which livestock can graze.
shape	The state of good health especially in the phrases in condition or in shape or out of condition or out of shape. <i>Most economists think the economy is in good shape.</i>
sorting	An operation that segregates items into groups according to a specified criterion. <i>The bottleneck in mail delivery is the process of sorting.</i>

conforming	Adhering to established customs or doctrines (especially in religion.
<u>conformist</u>	Adhering to established customs or doctrines (especially in religion. <i>The poet became more conformist in his later years.</i>
contour	Of a road or railway follow the outline of a topographical feature especially along a contour line. <i>The road contours the hillside.</i>
coordinate	Form a coordinate bond to an atom or molecule. <i>Coordinate the painters masons and plumbers.</i>
<u>correspond</u>	Have a close similarity; match or agree almost exactly. <i>The doctor and I corresponded for more than two decades.</i>
deployment	The action of bringing resources into effective action. <i>The authorities announced deployment of extra security forces in towns and cities to prevent violence.</i>
dimensional	Having dimension—the quality or character or stature proper to a person— Norman Cousins. <i>Well rounded fully dimensional characters.</i>
equine	Resembling a horse. <i>Equine infectious anaemia.</i>
form	An ability to perform well. <i>A form is as good as the writer who chooses it.</i>
grid	Put into or set out as a grid. <i>The 20 year old didn t get the best of starts off the grid.</i>
interface	Connect with another computer or piece of equipment by an interface. <i>The interface between accountancy and the law.</i>
<u>juxtaposition</u>	A side-by-side position. <i>The juxtaposition of these two images.</i>
lattice	An interlaced structure or pattern resembling a lattice. <i>Honeysuckle was growing up a lattice round the door.</i>
<u>layout</u>	A plan or design of something that is laid out. <i>Doing layout for newspapers and magazines.</i>
ordering	The act of putting things in a sequential arrangement. <i>There were mistakes in the ordering of items on the list.</i>
<u>organize</u>	Form or join a union. <i>The soul doth organize the body.</i>

placement	The act of putting something in a certain place. <i>A placement in a special school.</i>
plan	Make a design of plan out in systematic often graphic form. <i>She had planned the garden from scratch.</i>
<u>planned</u>	Planned in advance. <i>The planned outlays for new equipment.</i>
project	Make a projection of the earth sky etc on a plane surface. <i>Project a missile.</i>
scheme	Arrange according to a colour scheme. <i>I scheme it could work.</i>
<u>shape</u>	Give a particular shape or form to. <i>Debates about the future shape of British society.</i>
structure	Give a structure to. <i>The structure consisted of a series of arches.</i>
<u>tangible</u>	Perceptible by the senses especially the sense of touch. <i>Skin with a tangible roughness.</i>
