Present Tense	<b>conflagrate / conflagrates</b>
Past Tense	<b>conflagrated</b>
Present Participle	<b>conflagrating</b>
Past Participle	<b>conflagrated</b>

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I conflagrate**

**We conflagrate**

**You conflagrate**

**You conflagrate**

**He/She/It conflagrates**

**They conflagrate**

## **Conflagrate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I am conflagrating**

**We are conflagrating**

**You are conflagrating**

**You are conflagrating**

**He/She/It is conflagrating**

**They are conflagrating**

## **Conflagrate in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I have conflagrated**

**We have conflagrated**

**You have conflagrated**

**You have conflagrated**

**He/She/It has conflagrated**

**They have conflagrated**

## **Conflagrate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I have been conflagrating**

**We have been conflagrating**

**You have been conflagrating**

**You have been conflagrating**

**He/She/It has been conflagrating**

**They have been conflagrating**

## **Conflagrate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**I conflagrated**

**We conflagrated**

**You conflagrated**

**You conflagrated**

**He/She/It conflagrated**

**They conflagrated**

## **Conflagrate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I was conflagrating**

**We were conflagrating**

**You were conflagrating**

**You were conflagrating**

**He/She/It was conflagrating** **They were conflagrating**

**I had conflagrated**

**We had conflagrated**

**You had conflagrated**

**You had conflagrated**

**He/She/It had conflagrated** **They had conflagrated**
