Past Tense	<b>confronted</b>
Present Participle	<b>confronting</b>
Past Participle	<b>confronted</b>

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **confront**

We **confront**

You **confront**

You **confront**

He/She/It **confronts** They **confront**

## **Confront in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am confronting**

We **are confronting**

You **are confronting**

You **are confronting**

He/She/It **is confronting** They **are confronting**

## **Confront in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have confronted**

We **have confronted**

You **have confronted**

You **have confronted**

He/She/It **has confronted** They **have confronted**

## **Confront in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been confronting**

We **have been confronting**

You **have been confronting**

You **have been confronting**

He/She/It **has been confronting** They **have been confronting**

## **Confront in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **confronted**

We **confronted**

You **confronted**

You **confronted**

He/She/It **confronted** They **confronted**

## **Confront in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **was confronting**                      We **were confronting**  
You **were confronting**                You **were confronting**  
He/She/It **was confronting**        They **were confronting**

**Confront in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had confronted**                      We **had confronted**  
You **had confronted**                You **had confronted**  
He/She/It **had confronted**        They **had confronted**

**Confront in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had been confronting**                We **had been confronting**  
You **had been confronting**            You **had been confronting**  
He/She/It **had been confronting**    They **had been confronting**

**Confront in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will confront**                      We **will confront**  
You **will confront**                You **will confront**  
He/She/It **will confront**        They **will confront**

**Confront in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will be confronting**                We **will be confronting**  
You **will be confronting**            You **will be confronting**  
He/She/It **will be confronting**    They **will be confronting**

**Confront in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have confronted**

**We will have confronted**

**You will have confronted**

**You will have confronted**

**He/She/It will have confronted** **They will have confronted**

**I will have been confronting**

**We will have been confronting**

**You will have been confronting**

**You will have been confronting**

**He/She/It will have been confronting** **They will have been confronting**
