Conjugate Congregate

Congregate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I congregate We congregate
You congregate You congregate
He/She/It congregates They congregate

Congregate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am congregating We are congregating
You are congregating You are congregating
He/She/It is congregating They are congregating

Congregate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have congregated We have congregated You have congregated He/She/It has congregated They have congregated

Congregate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been congregating

You have been congregating

You have been congregating

He/She/It has been congregating

They have been congregating

Congregate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I congregated We congregated
You congregated You congregated
He/She/It congregated They congregated

Congregate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was congregating We were congregating
You were congregating You were congregating
He/She/It was congregating They were congregating

Congregate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had congregated We had congregated You had congregated He/She/It had congregated They had congregated

Congregate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been congregating
You had been congregating
He/She/It had been congregating
They had been congregating

Congregate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will congregate
You will congregate
He/She/It will congregate
They will congregate

Congregate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be congregating
You will be congregating
He/She/It will be congregating
They will be congregating

Congregate in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have congregated We will have congregated You will have congregated He/She/It will have congregated They will have congregated

Congregate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been congregating
You will have been congregating
He/She/It will have been congregating
They will have been congregating
