# **Conjugate Connive**

### **Connive in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I connive	We <b>connive</b>
You <b>connive</b>	You <b>connive</b>
He/She/It connives	They <b>connive</b>

### **Connive in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am conniving	We <b>are conniving</b>
You <b>are conniving</b>	You <b>are conniving</b>
He/She/It is conniving	They are conniving

### **Connive in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have connived	We have connived
You have connived	You have connived
He/She/It has connived	They have connived

### **Connive in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been conniving	We have been conniving
You have been conniving	You have been conniving
He/She/It has been conniving	They have been conniving

### **Connive in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I connived	We <b>connived</b>
You <b>connived</b>	You <b>connived</b>
He/She/It <b>connived</b>	They <b>connived</b>

### **Connive in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



SingularPluralI was connivingWe were connivingYou were connivingYou were connivingHe/She/It was connivingThey were conniving

#### **Connive in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had connived	We had connived
You had connived	You had connived
He/She/It had connived	They had connived

### **Connive in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been conniving	We had been conniving
You <b>had been conniving</b>	You had been conniving
He/She/It had been conniving	They had been conniving

### **Connive in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will connive	We will connive
You <b>will connive</b>	You <b>will connive</b>
He/She/It will connive	They will connive

### **Connive in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be conniving	We will be conniving
You <b>will be conniving</b>	You will be conniving
He/She/It will be conniving	They will be conniving

#### **Connive in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have connivedWe will have connivedYou will have connivedYou will have connivedHe/She/It will have connivedThey will have connived

### **Connive in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been conniving	We will have been conniving
You <b>will have been conniving</b>	You <b>will have been conniving</b>
He/She/It will have been conniving	They will have been conniving
