**Connive in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular****Plural**

I **connive**                      We **connive**  
You **connive**                You **connive**  
He/She/It **connives**    They **connive**

**Connive in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense****Singular****Plural**

I **am conniving**              We **are conniving**  
You **are conniving**        You **are conniving**  
He/She/It **is conniving**    They **are conniving**

**Connive in Present Perfect Tense****Singular****Plural**

I **have connived**              We **have connived**  
You **have connived**        You **have connived**  
He/She/It **has connived**    They **have connived**

**Connive in Present Perfect Continuous Tense****Singular****Plural**

I **have been conniving**        We **have been conniving**  
You **have been conniving**    You **have been conniving**  
He/She/It **has been conniving**    They **have been conniving**

**Connive in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense****Singular****Plural**

I **connived**                      We **connived**  
You **connived**                You **connived**  
He/She/It **connived**        They **connived**

He/She/It <b>was conniving</b>	They <b>were conniving</b>
