Cons in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **cons** We **cons**
You **cons** You **cons**
He/She/It **conses** They **cons**

Cons in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I **am consing** We **are consing**
You **are consing** You **are consing**
He/She/It **is consing** They **are consing**

Cons in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I **have consed** We **have consed**
You **have consed** You **have consed**
He/She/It **has consed** They **have consed**

Cons in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I **have been consing** We **have been consing**
You **have been consing** You **have been consing**
He/She/It **has been consing** They **have been consing**

Cons in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **consed** We **consed**
You **consed** You **consed**
He/She/It **consed** They **consed**

Cons in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **was consing** We **were consing**
You **were consing** You **were consing**
He/She/It **was consing** They **were consing**

Cons in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **had consed** We **had consed**
You **had consed** You **had consed**
He/She/It **had consed** They **had consed**

Cons in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **had been consing** We **had been consing**
You **had been consing** You **had been consing**
He/She/It **had been consing** They **had been consing**

Cons in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **will cons** We **will cons**
You **will cons** You **will cons**
He/She/It **will cons** They **will cons**

Cons in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **will be consing** We **will be consing**
You **will be consing** You **will be consing**
He/She/It **will be consing** They **will be consing**

Cons in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have consed

We will have consed

You will have consed

You will have consed

He/She/It will have consed

They will have consed

Cons in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been consing

We will have been consing

You will have been consing

You will have been consing

He/She/It will have been consing

They will have been consing
