Present Tense	<b>consecrate / consecrates</b>
Past Tense	<b>consecrated</b>
Present Participle	<b>consecrating</b>
Past Participle	<b>consecrated</b>

## Conjugate Consecrate

**Consecrate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>consecrate</b>	We <b>consecrate</b>
You <b>consecrate</b>	You <b>consecrate</b>
He/She/It <b>consecrates</b>	They <b>consecrate</b>

**Consecrate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am consecrating</b>	We <b>are consecrating</b>
You <b>are consecrating</b>	You <b>are consecrating</b>
He/She/It <b>is consecrating</b>	They <b>are consecrating</b>

**Consecrate in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have consecrated</b>	We <b>have consecrated</b>
You <b>have consecrated</b>	You <b>have consecrated</b>
He/She/It <b>has consecrated</b>	They <b>have consecrated</b>

**Consecrate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have been consecrating</b>	We <b>have been consecrating</b>
You <b>have been consecrating</b>	You <b>have been consecrating</b>
He/She/It <b>has been consecrating</b>	They <b>have been consecrating</b>

**Consecrate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>consecrated</b>	We <b>consecrated</b>
You <b>consecrated</b>	You <b>consecrated</b>
He/She/It <b>consecrated</b>	They <b>consecrated</b>

**Consecrate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **was consecrating**      We **were consecrating**  
You **were consecrating**      You **were consecrating**  
He/She/It **was consecrating**      They **were consecrating**

**Consecrate in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had consecrated**      We **had consecrated**  
You **had consecrated**      You **had consecrated**  
He/She/It **had consecrated**      They **had consecrated**

**Consecrate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had been consecrating**      We **had been consecrating**  
You **had been consecrating**      You **had been consecrating**  
He/She/It **had been consecrating**      They **had been consecrating**

**Consecrate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will consecrate**      We **will consecrate**  
You **will consecrate**      You **will consecrate**  
He/She/It **will consecrate**      They **will consecrate**

**Consecrate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will be consecrating**      We **will be consecrating**  
You **will be consecrating**      You **will be consecrating**  
He/She/It **will be consecrating**      They **will be consecrating**

**Consecrate in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have consecrated**

**We will have consecrated**

**You will have consecrated**

**You will have consecrated**

**He/She/It will have consecrated**

**They will have consecrated**

**Consecrate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been consecrating**

**We will have been consecrating**

**You will have been consecrating**

**You will have been consecrating**

**He/She/It will have been consecrating**

**They will have been consecrating**
