Present Tense	<b>consecute / consecutes</b>
Past Tense	<b>consecuted</b>
Present Participle	<b>consecuting</b>
Past Participle	<b>consecuted</b>

## Conjugate Consecute

### Consecute in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **consecute**                      We **consecute**  
You **consecute**                You **consecute**  
He/She/It **consecutes**    They **consecute**

**Consecute in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am consecuting**            We **are consecuting**  
You **are consecuting**        You **are consecuting**  
He/She/It **is consecuting**    They **are consecuting**

**Consecute in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have consecuted**            We **have consecuted**  
You **have consecuted**        You **have consecuted**  
He/She/It **has consecuted**    They **have consecuted**

**Consecute in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been consecuting**        We **have been consecuting**  
You **have been consecuting**      You **have been consecuting**  
He/She/It **has been consecuting**    They **have been consecuting**

**Consecute in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **consecuted**                    We **consecuted**  
You **consecuted**                You **consecuted**  
He/She/It **consecuted**        They **consecuted**

**Consecute in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **was consecuting**                      We **were consecuting**  
You **were consecuting**                You **were consecuting**  
He/She/It **was consecuting**        They **were consecuting**

**Consecute in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had consecuted**                      We **had consecuted**  
You **had consecuted**                You **had consecuted**  
He/She/It **had consecuted**        They **had consecuted**

**Consecute in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had been consecuting**                We **had been consecuting**  
You **had been consecuting**            You **had been consecuting**  
He/She/It **had been consecuting**    They **had been consecuting**

**Consecute in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will consecute**                      We **will consecute**  
You **will consecute**                You **will consecute**  
He/She/It **will consecute**        They **will consecute**

**Consecute in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will be consecuting**                We **will be consecuting**  
You **will be consecuting**            You **will be consecuting**  
He/She/It **will be consecuting**    They **will be consecuting**

**Consecute in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have consecuted**

**We will have consecuted**

**You will have consecuted**

**You will have consecuted**

**He/She/It will have consecuted** **They will have consecuted**

**Consecute in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been consecuting**

**We will have been consecuting**

**You will have been consecuting**

**You will have been consecuting**

**He/She/It will have been consecuting** **They will have been consecuting**
