Consequence in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I consequence We consequence
You consequence You consequence
He/She/It consequences They consequence

Consequence in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am consequencing We are consequencing
You are consequencing
He/She/It is consequencing They are consequencing

Consequence in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have consequenced We have consequenced You have consequenced He/She/It has consequenced They have consequenced

Consequence in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been consequencing

You have been consequencing

You have been consequencing

He/She/It has been consequencing

They have been consequencing

Consequence in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I consequenced We consequenced
You consequenced You consequenced
He/She/It consequenced They consequenced

Consequence in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was consequencing We were consequencing
You were consequencing
He/She/It was consequencing They were consequencing

Consequence in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had consequenced We had consequenced You had consequenced You had consequenced He/She/It had consequenced They had consequenced

Consequence in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been consequencing

You had been consequencing

You had been consequencing

He/She/It had been consequencing

They had been consequencing

Consequence in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will consequence We will consequence
You will consequence You will consequence
He/She/It will consequence They will consequence

Consequence in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be consequencing
You will be consequencing
He/She/It will be consequencing
They will be consequencing

Consequence in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have consequenced We will have consequenced You will have consequenced He/She/It will have consequenced They will have consequenced

Consequence in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been consequencing
You will have been consequencing
He/She/It will have been consequencing
They will have been consequencing
