Past Tense **considered**Present Participle **considering**Past Participle **considered**

Conjugate Consider

Consider in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I **consider** We **consider** You **consider** You **consider**

He/She/It considers They consider

Consider in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am considering We are considering
You are considering You are considering
He/She/It is considering They are considering

Consider in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have considered We have considered You have considered He/She/It has considered They have considered

Consider in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been considering
You have been considering
He/She/It has been considering
They have been considering

Consider in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **considered** We **considered**You **considered** You **considered**He/She/It **considered** They **considered**

Consider in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was considering We were considering
You were considering You were considering
He/She/It was considering They were considering

Consider in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had considered We had considered
You had considered You had considered
He/She/It had considered They had considered

Consider in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been considering
You had been considering
He/She/It had been considering
They had been considering
We had been considering
You had been considering

Consider in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will consider
You will consider
He/She/It will consider They will consider

Consider in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be considering
You will be considering
He/She/It will be considering
They will be considering

Consider in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have considered We will have considered You will have considered He/She/It will have considered They will have considered

Consider in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been considering
You will have been considering
He/She/It will have been considering
They will have been considering
