Definitions of "Console" as a verb

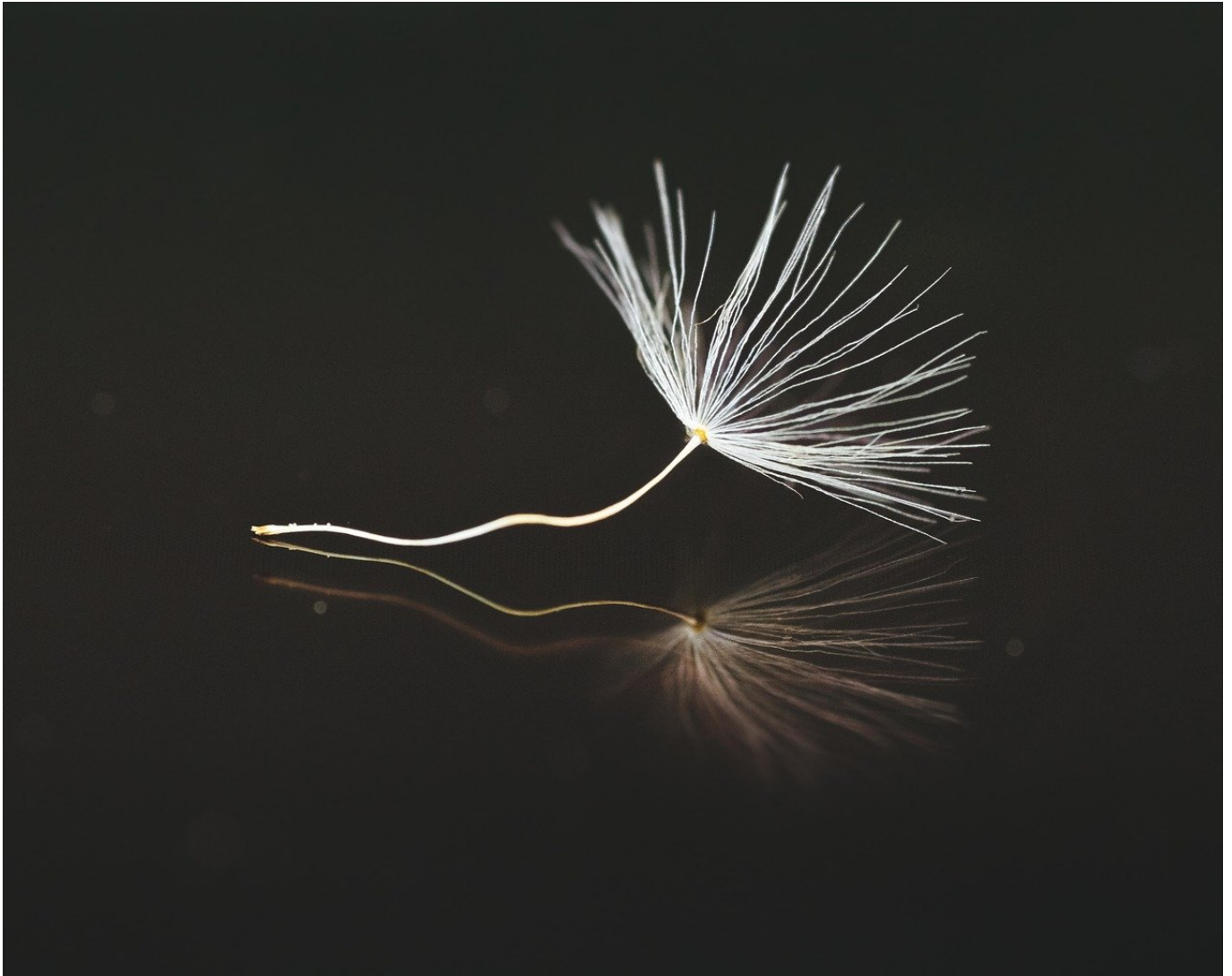
According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "console" as a verb can have the following definitions:

Synonyms of "Console" as a verb (5 Words)

comfort	Lessen pain or discomfort alleviate. <i>He dined outdoors comforted by the crackling sounds of the fire.</i>
condole with	Share the suffering of.
give condolences to	Convey or reveal information.
<u>solace</u>	Give moral or emotional strength to. <i>I solaced myself with a slab of chocolate.</i>
soothe	Give moral or emotional strength to. <i>It contains a mild anaesthetic to soothe the pain.</i>



Usage Examples of "Console" as a verb

- *You can console yourself with the thought that you did your best.*
- *She tried to console him but he pushed her gently away.*

antechamber	A small room leading to a main one. <i>The antechamber to an interview room.</i>
bathroom	A set of matching units to be fitted in a bathroom especially as sold together. <i>I have to go to the bathroom.</i>
<u>bedroom</u>	A room for sleeping in. <i>A hotel with nearly 200 bedrooms.</i>
bowl	Engage in the sport of bowling. <i>Their last four bowl games.</i>
<u>bucket</u>	Carry in a bucket. <i>She emptied a bucket of water over them.</i>
<u>cabinet</u>	(in the UK, Canada, and other Commonwealth countries) the committee of senior ministers responsible for controlling government policy. <i>A cocktail cabinet.</i>
cleaver	A tool with a heavy, broad blade, used by butchers for chopping meat. <i>A meat cleaver.</i>
doorstep	The sill of a door; a horizontal piece of wood or stone that forms the bottom of a doorway and offers support when passing through a doorway. <i>He put his foot on the doorstep of the cottage.</i>
drawer	A person who writes a cheque. <i>The banker would have rights as holder to pursue the drawer.</i>
faucet	A regulator for controlling the flow of a liquid from a reservoir.
<u>furniture</u>	The mountings of a rifle. <i>The more sophisticated Mac furniture number wheels colour pickers and so on.</i>
gallon	A unit of liquid capacity equal to 3.79 litres. <i>Gallons of fake blood.</i>
gateway	An entrance that can be closed by a gate. <i>To me a home in the country was a gateway to happiness.</i>
hatchet	Weapon consisting of a fighting ax; used by North American Indians.
jamb	A side post or surface of a doorway, window, or fireplace. <i>He leaned against the door jamb.</i>
<u>kitchen</u>	A set of fittings and units that are sold together and fixed in place in a kitchen. <i>The dried shrimp pastes of the Thai kitchen.</i>

knock	The sound of knocking as on a door or in an engine or bearing. <i>The school of hard knocks.</i>
latticed	Having a pattern of fretwork or latticework. <i>A latticed screen.</i>
lintel	Horizontal beam used as a finishing piece over a door or window.
pail	The quantity contained in a pail.
pane	A panel or section of panels in a wall or door.
rack	Go at a rack. <i>The newspapers were arranged on a rack.</i>
restroom	A toilet that is available to the public.
<u>room</u>	The people present in a room. <i>I was rooming with my cousin.</i>
sill	An underwater ridge or rock ledge extending across the bed of a body of water.
<u>suite</u>	A musical composition of several movements only loosely connected. <i>Potassic rock suites are a characteristic feature of the area.</i>
threshold	A region marking a boundary. <i>Their water would meet the safety threshold of 50 milligrams of nitrates per litre.</i>
tub	The contents of a tub or the amount it can contain. <i>Tubbed fruit trees.</i>
upstairs	On or to an upper floor of a building. <i>They lived upstairs.</i>
<u>window</u>	An opening that resembles a window in appearance or function. <i>Beautiful window displays.</i>
