Infinitive	<b>to consubstantiate</b>
Present Tense	<b>consubstantiate / consubstantiates</b>
Past Tense	<b>consubstantiated</b>
Present Participle	<b>consubstantiating</b>
Past Participle	<b>consubstantiated</b>

## Conjugate Consubstantiate

### Consubstantiate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>consubstantiate</b>	We <b>consubstantiate</b>
You <b>consubstantiate</b>	You <b>consubstantiate</b>
He/She/It <b>consubstantiates</b>	They <b>consubstantiate</b>

**Consubstantiate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am consubstantiating</b>	We <b>are consubstantiating</b>
You <b>are consubstantiating</b>	You <b>are consubstantiating</b>
He/She/It <b>is consubstantiating</b>	They <b>are consubstantiating</b>

**Consubstantiate in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have consubstantiated</b>	We <b>have consubstantiated</b>
You <b>have consubstantiated</b>	You <b>have consubstantiated</b>
He/She/It <b>has consubstantiated</b>	They <b>have consubstantiated</b>

**Consubstantiate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Plural**

I <b>have been consubstantiating</b>	We <b>have been consubstantiating</b>
You <b>have been consubstantiating</b>	You <b>have been consubstantiating</b>
He/She/It <b>has been consubstantiating</b>	They <b>have been consubstantiating</b>

I **was** **consubstantiating**      We **were** **consubstantiating**  
You **were** **consubstantiating**      You **were** **consubstantiating**  
He/She/It **was** **consubstantiating**      They **were** **consubstantiating**

**Consubstantiate in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had** **consubstantiated**      We **had** **consubstantiated**  
You **had** **consubstantiated**      You **had** **consubstantiated**  
He/She/It **had** **consubstantiated**      They **had** **consubstantiated**

**Consubstantiate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had been** **consubstantiating**      We **had been** **consubstantiating**  
You **had been** **consubstantiating**      You **had been** **consubstantiating**  
He/She/It **had been** **consubstantiating**      They **had been** **consubstantiating**

**Consubstantiate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Plural**

I **will** **consubstantiate**      We **will** **consubstantiate**  
You **will** **consubstantiate**      You **will** **consubstantiate**  
He/She/It **will** **consubstantiate**      They **will** **consubstantiate**

**Consubstantiate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I **will be** **consubstantiating**      We **will be** **consubstantiating**  
You **will be** **consubstantiating**      You **will be** **consubstantiating**  
He/She/It **will be** **consubstantiating**      They **will be** **consubstantiating**

**Consubstantiate in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have consubstantiated**

**We will have consubstantiated**

**You will have consubstantiated**

**You will have consubstantiated**

**He/She/It will have consubstantiated** **They will have consubstantiated**

**Consubstantiate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been consubstantiating**

**We will have been consubstantiating**

**You will have been consubstantiating**

**You will have been consubstantiating**

**He/She/It will have been consubstantiating** **They will have been consubstantiating**
