- The state of being contaminated.

pollution	The state of being polluted. The level of <b>pollution</b> in the air is rising.
taint	A trace of a bad or undesirable substance or quality. The <b>taint</b> that threatens to stain most of the company s other partners.

adulteration	Being mixed with extraneous material; the product of adulterating. We re working on a new diagnostic test to more rapidly monitor food <b>adulteration</b> .
besmirch	Make (something) dirty or discoloured. He had <b>besmirch</b> ed the good name of his family.
contaminate	Make impure. The site was found to be <b>contaminate</b> d by radioactivity.
contaminated	Rendered unwholesome by contaminants and pollution. <i>Contaminated evidence.</i>
debasement	Being mixed with extraneous material; the product of adulterating. The outcome is rot and <b>debasement</b> of the system.
<u>defile</u>	Rape or sexually assault (a woman. The tomb had been <b>defile</b> d and looted.



Morally blemished; stained or impure.
The action of overcoming a rival or threat. The <b>disposal</b> of radioactive waste.
That is flowing outward. <i>Contamination with trade <b>effluent</b>s.</i>
Any of several bodily processes by which substances go out of the body. <i>Nocturnal emissions.</i>
The surroundings or conditions in which a person, animal, or plant lives or operates. <i>A good learning environment</i> .
Of or relating to the external conditions or surroundings. <i>Environmental noise</i> .
Chiefly of atoms undergo fission. The <b>fission</b> of uranium atoms in a chain reaction.
Hit a foul ball. With its sails a <b>foul</b> .
Covered with or characterized by grime. <i>Grimy</i> hands.
Having a physical or moral blemish so as to make impure according to dietary or ceremonial laws. <i>Impure thoughts.</i>
Communicate a disease to. The panic in his voice <b>infect</b> ed her.
Morally blemished; stained or impure. A dirty white T shirt <b>maculate</b> d with barbecue sauce.
Contaminate (water, the air, etc.) with harmful or poisonous substances. <i>The industrial wastes</i> <b>pollute</b> <i>d the lake</i> .
Rendered unwholesome by contaminants and pollution. <i>One of Europe s most <b>polluted</b> rivers.</i>
The state of being polluted. The level of <b>pollution</b> in the air is rising.
Exhibiting or caused by radioactivity. <i>Radioactive</i> decay.
Rough and covered with, or as if with, scabs. A <b>scabrous</b> hovel.
Be marked or be liable to be marked with a stain. People knew how to <b>stain</b> glass a beautiful blue in the middle ages.



sully	Place under suspicion or cast doubt upon. They were outraged that anyone should <b>sully</b> their good name.
taint	The state of being contaminated. <i>His administration was <b>taint</b>ed by scandal.</i>
<u>tarnish</u>	A film or stain formed on an exposed surface of a mineral or metal. The <b>tarnish</b> on Alan s personal reputation.
unclean	Dirty. <b>Unclean</b> meat.
unsanitary	Not sanitary or healthful. The <b>unsanitary</b> conditions in the orphanage.
