Infinitive	<b>to temperate</b>
Present Tense	<b>temperate / tempers</b>
Past Tense	<b>contempered</b>
Present Participle	<b>tempering</b>
Past Participle	<b>contempered</b>

## Conjugate Temperate

**Temperate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>contemperate</b>	We <b>contemperate</b>
You <b>contemperate</b>	You <b>contemperate</b>
He/She/It <b>contempers</b>	They <b>contemperate</b>

**Contemperate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am contemperating</b>	We <b>are contemperating</b>
You <b>are contemperating</b>	You <b>are contemperating</b>
He/She/It <b>is contemperating</b>	They <b>are contemperating</b>

**Contemperate in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have contempered</b>	We <b>have contempered</b>
You <b>have contempered</b>	You <b>have contempered</b>
He/She/It <b>has contempered</b>	They <b>have contempered</b>

**Contemperate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have been contemperating</b>	We <b>have been contemperating</b>
You <b>have been contemperating</b>	You <b>have been contemperating</b>
He/She/It <b>has been contemperating</b>	They <b>have been contemperating</b>

**Contemperate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>contempered</b>	We <b>contempered</b>
You <b>contempered</b>	You <b>contempered</b>
He/She/It <b>contempered</b>	They <b>contempered</b>

**Contemperate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was tempering                      We were tempering  
You were tempering                You were tempering  
He/She/It was tempering        They were tempering

**Temperate in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had tempered                      We had tempered  
You had tempered                    You had tempered  
He/She/It had tempered        They had tempered

**Temperate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been tempering                We had been tempering  
You had been tempering              You had been tempering  
He/She/It had been tempering      They had been tempering

**Temperate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will temperate                      We will temperate  
You will temperate                    You will temperate  
He/She/It will temperate        They will temperate

**Temperate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be tempering                    We will be tempering  
You will be tempering                You will be tempering  
He/She/It will be tempering        They will be tempering

**Temperate in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have contemperated**

**We will have contemperated**

**You will have contemperated**

**You will have contemperated**

**He/She/It will have contemperated** **They will have contemperated**

**Contemperate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been contemperating**

**We will have been contemperating**

**You will have been contemperating**

**You will have been contemperating**

**He/She/It will have been contemperating** **They will have been contemperating**
