The Forms of Contemperate

Infinitive to contemperate

Conjugate Contemperate

Contemperate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I contemperate
You contemperate
He/She/It contemperates They contemperate

Contemperate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am contemperating We are contemperating
You are contemperating
He/She/It is contemperating They are contemperating

Contemperate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have contemperated We have contemperated You have contemperated You have contemperated He/She/It has contemperated They have contemperated

Contemperate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been contemperating
You have been contemperating
He/She/It has been contemperating
They have been contemperating

Contemperate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I contemperated We contemperated You contemperated You contemperated He/She/It contemperated They contemperated

Contemperate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was contemperating We were contemperating
You were contemperating
He/She/It was contemperating They were contemperating

Contemperate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had contemperated We had contemperated You had contemperated He/She/It had contemperated They had contemperated

Contemperate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been contemperating
You had been contemperating
He/She/It had been contemperating
They had been contemperating

Contemperate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will contemperate
You will contemperate
He/She/It will contemperate
They will contemperate

Contemperate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be contemperating
You will be contemperating
He/She/It will be contemperating
They will be contemperating

Contemperate in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have contemperated We will have contemperated You will have contemperated He/She/It will have contemperated They will have contemperated

Contemperate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been contemperating
You will have been contemperating
He/She/It will have been contemperating
They will have been contemperating
