Continue in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

I continue We continue
You continue You continue
He/She/It continues They continue

Continue in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am continuing We are continuing
You are continuing You are continuing
He/She/It is continuing They are continuing

Continue in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have continued We have continued You have continued You have continued He/She/It has continued They have continued

Continue in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been continuing
You have been continuing
You have been continuing
He/She/It has been continuing
They have been continuing

Continue in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Continue in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was continuing We were continuing
You were continuing
He/She/It was continuing They were continuing

Continue in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had continued We had continued You had continued You had continued He/She/It had continued They had continued

Continue in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been continuing
You had been continuing
He/She/It had been continuing
They had been continuing

Continue in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will continue We will continue
You will continue You will continue
He/She/It will continue They will continue

Continue in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be continuing
You will be continuing
He/She/It will be continuing
They will be continuing

Continue in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have continued We will have continued You will have continued He/She/It will have continued They will have continued

Continue in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been continuing
You will have been continuing
He/She/It will have been continuing
They will have been continuing
