Contrary in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I contrary	We contrary
You contrary	You contrary
He/She/It contraries	They contrary

Contrary in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am contrarying	We are contrarying
You are contrarying	You are contrarying
He/She/It is contrarying	They are contrarying

Contrary in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have contraried	We have contraried
You have contraried	You have contraried
He/She/It has contraried	They have contraried

Contrary in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been contrarying	We have been contrarying
You have been contrarying	You have been contrarying
He/She/It has been contrarying	They have been contrarying

Contrary in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I contraried	We contraried
You contraried	You contraried
He/She/It contraried	They contraried

Contrary in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was contrarying	We were contrarying
You were contrarying	You were contrarying
He/She/It was contrarying	They were contrarying

Contrary in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had contraried	We had contraried
You had contraried	You had contraried
He/She/It had contraried	They had contraried

Contrary in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been contrarying	We had been contrarying
You had been contrarying	You had been contrarying
He/She/It had been contrarying	They had been contrarying

Contrary in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will contrary	We will contrary
You will contrary	You will contrary
He/She/It will contrary	They will contrary

Contrary in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be contrarying	We will be contrarying
You will be contrarying	You will be contrarying
He/She/It will be contrarying	They will be contrarying
