Controverse in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I controverse We controverse
You controverse You controverse
He/She/It controverses They controverse

Controverse in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am controversing We are controversing
You are controversing You are controversing
He/She/It is controversing They are controversing

Controverse in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have controversed We have controversed You have controversed He/She/It has controversed They have controversed

Controverse in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been controversing
You have been controversing
He/She/It has been controversing
They have been controversing

Controverse in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I controversed We controversed
You controversed You controversed
He/She/It controversed They controversed

Controverse in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was controversing We were controversing
You were controversing
He/She/It was controversing They were controversing

Controverse in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had controversed We had controversed
You had controversed You had controversed
He/She/It had controversed They had controversed

Controverse in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been controversing
You had been controversing
He/She/It had been controversing
They had been controversing
You had been controversing
They had been controversing

Controverse in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will controverse
You will controverse
He/She/It will controverse
They will controverse

Controverse in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be controversing
You will be controversing
He/She/It will be controversing
They will be controversing

Controverse in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have controversed We will have controversed You will have controversed He/She/It will have controversed They will have controversed

Controverse in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been controversing
You will have been controversing
He/She/It will have been controversing
They will have been controversing
