Infinitive	<b>to conventionalise</b>
Present Tense	<b>conventionalise / conventionalises</b>
Past Tense	<b>conventionalised</b>
Present Participle	<b>conventionalising</b>
Past Participle	<b>conventionalised</b>

## Conjugate Conventionalise

### Conventionalise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>conventionalise</b>	We <b>conventionalise</b>
You <b>conventionalise</b>	You <b>conventionalise</b>
He/She/It <b>conventionalises</b>	They <b>conventionalise</b>

**Conventionalise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am conventionalising</b>	We <b>are conventionalising</b>
You <b>are conventionalising</b>	You <b>are conventionalising</b>
He/She/It <b>is conventionalising</b>	They <b>are conventionalising</b>

**Conventionalise in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have conventionalised</b>	We <b>have conventionalised</b>
You <b>have conventionalised</b>	You <b>have conventionalised</b>
He/She/It <b>has conventionalised</b>	They <b>have conventionalised</b>

**Conventionalise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have been conventionalising</b>	We <b>have been conventionalising</b>
You <b>have been conventionalising</b>	You <b>have been conventionalising</b>
He/She/It <b>has been conventionalising</b>	They <b>have been conventionalising</b>

**Conventionalise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>conventionalised</b>	We <b>conventionalised</b>
You <b>conventionalised</b>	You <b>conventionalised</b>
He/She/It <b>conventionalised</b>	They <b>conventionalised</b>

**Conventionalise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **was conventionalising**                      We **were conventionalising**  
You **were conventionalising**              You **were conventionalising**  
He/She/It **was conventionalising**      They **were conventionalising**

**Conventionalise in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had conventionalised**                      We **had conventionalised**  
You **had conventionalised**                  You **had conventionalised**  
He/She/It **had conventionalised**      They **had conventionalised**

**Conventionalise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had been conventionalising**              We **had been conventionalising**  
You **had been conventionalising**          You **had been conventionalising**  
He/She/It **had been conventionalising**      They **had been conventionalising**

**Conventionalise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will conventionalise**                      We **will conventionalise**  
You **will conventionalise**                  You **will conventionalise**  
He/She/It **will conventionalise**      They **will conventionalise**

**Conventionalise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will be conventionalising**                  We **will be conventionalising**  
You **will be conventionalising**              You **will be conventionalising**  
He/She/It **will be conventionalising**      They **will be conventionalising**

**Conventionalise in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have conventionalised**

**We will have conventionalised**

**You will have conventionalised**

**You will have conventionalised**

**He/She/It will have conventionalised** **They will have conventionalised**

**Conventionalise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been conventionalising**

**We will have been conventionalising**

**You will have been conventionalising**

**You will have been conventionalising**

**He/She/It will have been conventionalising** **They will have been conventionalising**
