Convict in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **convict** We **convict**
You **convict** You **convict**
He/She/It **convicts** They **convict**

Convict in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am convicting** We **are convicting**
You **are convicting** You **are convicting**
He/She/It **is convicting** They **are convicting**

Convict in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have convicted** We **have convicted**
You **have convicted** You **have convicted**
He/She/It **has convicted** They **have convicted**

Convict in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have been convicting** We **have been convicting**
You **have been convicting** You **have been convicting**
He/She/It **has been convicting** They **have been convicting**

Convict in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **convicted** We **convicted**
You **convicted** You **convicted**
He/She/It **convicted** They **convicted**

Convict in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **was convicting** We **were convicting**
You **were convicting** You **were convicting**
He/She/It **was convicting** They **were convicting**

Convict in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **had convicted** We **had convicted**
You **had convicted** You **had convicted**
He/She/It **had convicted** They **had convicted**

Convict in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **had been convicting** We **had been convicting**
You **had been convicting** You **had been convicting**
He/She/It **had been convicting** They **had been convicting**

Convict in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **will convict** We **will convict**
You **will convict** You **will convict**
He/She/It **will convict** They **will convict**

Convict in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **will be convicting** We **will be convicting**
You **will be convicting** You **will be convicting**
He/She/It **will be convicting** They **will be convicting**

Convict in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have convicted

We will have convicted

You will have convicted

You will have convicted

He/She/It will have convicted

They will have convicted

Convict in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been convicting

We will have been convicting

You will have been convicting

You will have been convicting

He/She/It will have been convicting

They will have been convicting
