bacon	English statesman and philosopher; precursor of British empiricism; advocated inductive reasoning (1561-1626). <i>A bacon sandwich.</i>
bake	A social gathering at which baked food of a specified kind is eaten. <i>Bake the potatoes.</i>
baked	(of food) cooked by dry heat in an oven. <i>I just want to get baked and watch a movie.</i>
bakery	A place where bread and cakes are made or sold. <i>Bakery items.</i>
bread	Cover with bread crumbs. <i>A bread roll.</i>
cake	Small flat mass of chopped food. <i>The blood under his nose was beginning to cake.</i>
cinnamon	Spice from the dried aromatic bark of the Ceylon cinnamon tree used as rolled strips or ground. <i>He wore a short sleeved shirt and pale cinnamon slacks.</i>
cooked	(of food or a meal) prepared by heating. <i>As the result of cooked books stock prices soared.</i>
crisp	Make wrinkles or creases on a smooth surface make a pressed folded or wrinkled line in crisp is archaic. <i>The crisp snap of dry leaves underfoot.</i>
crispy	(of food) having a firm, dry, and brittle surface or texture. <i>Crispy fried bacon.</i>
crumb	Remove crumbs from. <i>A crispy crumb topping.</i>
crumble	A pudding made with crumble and fruit. <i>The party's fragile unity began to crumble.</i>

crust	Form a crust or form into a crust. A crust of snow.
deli	A shop selling ready-to-eat food products.
fried	Exhausted or worn out. <i>I had just come from doing a shoot and I was really fried.</i>
fry	A social gathering where fried food is served. <i>Put half a dozen steaks to fry in a pan.</i>
grill	Cook over or under a grill. Grill the trout for five minutes.
grilled	Cooked over an outdoor grill.
ham	Son of Noah. <i>Thin slices of ham.</i>
loaf	A shaped mass of baked bread that is usually sliced before eating. <i>Sugar loaf.</i>
oven	A small furnace or kiln. <i>The sun was beating down on to my little tent and it was like an oven in there.</i>
pastry	An item of food consisting of sweet pastry with a cream jam or fruit filling. <i>Spread the mixture over the pastry.</i>
pizza	A dish of Italian origin, consisting of a flat round base of dough baked with a topping of tomatoes and cheese, typically with added meat, fish, or vegetables. <i>A cheese and tomato pizza.</i>
pork	Gorge oneself with food. Pork chops.
raisin	A partially dried grape.
roast	An outdoor party at which meat of a particular type is roasted. <i>She was going to roast a leg of mutton for Sunday dinner.</i>
sandwich	Something that is constructed like or has the form of a sandwich. <i>The girl was sandwiched between two burly men in the back of the car.</i>
sausage	An object shaped like a sausage. <i>Silly sausage he teased.</i>
smoked	Dried and cured by hanging in wood smoke. <i>They were hidden behind the smoked glass of their limos.</i>
toaster	An electrical device for making toast.
