consultant	An expert who gives advice. <i>He acted as campaign consultant to the president.</i>
cooperate	Work jointly towards the same end. The leaders promised to cooperate in ending the civil war.
<u>cooperative</u>	(of a farm, business, etc.) owned and run jointly by its members, with profits or benefits shared among them. We run the agency as a workers cooperative .
employed	Put to use. Up to 40 per cent of employed people are in part time jobs.
