## Associations of "Coordinates" (30 Words)

<a href="#">adapt</a>	Adapt or conform oneself to new or different conditions. <i>A large organization can be slow to <b>adapt</b> to change.</i>
<b>adjust</b>	Alter or move (something) slightly in order to achieve the desired fit, appearance, or result. <i>He smoothed his hair and <b>adjusted</b> his tie.</i>
<b>align</b>	Align oneself with a group or a way of thinking. <i>All of them must now <b>align</b> against the foe.</i>
<a href="#">alongside</a>	Side by side.
<a href="#">arrange</a>	Arrange thoughts ideas temporal events. <i>I <b>arranged</b> with my boss to have the time off.</i>
<a href="#">array</a>	Display or arrange (things) in a particular way. <i>He was clothed in fine <b>array</b>.</i>
<a href="#">codify</a>	Arrange (laws or rules) into a systematic code. <i>This would <b>codify</b> existing intergovernmental cooperation on drugs.</i>
<a href="#">configuration</a>	An arrangement of parts or elements. <i>The unrepeatable <b>configuration</b> of the stars at the moment of your birth.</i>
<b>deploy</b>	Place troops or weapons in battle formation. <i>The U S <b>deploys</b> its weapons in the Middle East.</i>
<b>dimensional</b>	Having dimension—the quality or character or stature proper to a person. <i>Well rounded fully <b>dimensional</b> characters.</i>
<b>establish</b>	Establish the validity of something as by an example explanation or experiment. <i><b>Establish</b> the location with a wide shot.</i>
<b>form</b>	Make or be made into a specific shape or form. <i>He filled out his tax <b>form</b>.</i>
<b>harmonize</b>	Bring (several things) into consonance or relate harmoniously. <i><b>Harmonize</b> one s goals with one s abilities.</i>

<b>horizontally</b>	In a horizontal position or direction. <i>Labels are placed <b>horizontally</b> on the cases.</i>
<b>institute</b>	An association organized to promote art or science or education. <i>A testator who has <b>instituted</b> his daughter heir.</i>
<b>lineation</b>	The act of marking or outlining with lines. <i>Magnetic <b>lineations</b>.</i>
<b><u>orchestrate</u></b>	Arrange or score (music) for orchestral performance. <i>The song cycle was stunningly arranged and <b>orchestrated</b>.</i>
<b>ordered</b>	Marked by an orderly, logical, and aesthetically consistent relation of parts. <i>An <b>ordered</b> sequence.</i>
<b>ordering</b>	The act of putting things in a sequential arrangement. <i>There were mistakes in the <b>ordering</b> of items on the list.</i>
<b>organization</b>	An organized structure for arranging or classifying. <i>He was brought in to supervise the <b>organization</b> of a new department.</i>
<b><u>organize</u></b>	Bring order and organization to. <i><b>Organize</b> lessons in a planned way.</i>
<b><u>planned</u></b>	Planned in advance. <i>The <b>planned</b> outlays for new equipment.</i>
<b><u>prepare</u></b>	To prepare verbally either for written or spoken delivery. <i>She took time off to <b>prepare</b> for her exams.</i>
<b>ready</b>	Make ready or suitable or equip in advance for a particular purpose or for some use event etc. <i>The bridge is <b>ready</b> to collapse.</i>
<b><u>reconcile</u></b>	Make (one account) consistent with another, especially by allowing for transactions begun but not yet completed. <i>He was <b>reconciled</b> to leaving.</i>
<b>relocation</b>	The act of changing your residence or place of business. <i>The planned <b>relocation</b> of national headquarters to Warwickshire.</i>
<b>set</b>	Set to a certain position or cause to operate correctly. <i><b>Set</b> a broken bone.</i>
<b>setup</b>	The way something is organized or arranged. <i>It takes time to learn the <b>setup</b> around here.</i>
<b>sizing</b>	Any glutinous material used to fill pores in surfaces or to stiffen fabrics.
<b>vertically</b>	At right angles to a horizontal plane; aligned in such a way that the top is directly above the bottom. <i>The wheel hangs <b>vertically</b> from a wire.</i>
