Associations of "Coordinates" (30 Words)

<u>adapt</u>	Adapt or conform oneself to new or different conditions. <i>A large organization can be slow to adapt to change.</i>
adjust	Alter or move (something) slightly in order to achieve the desired fit, appearance, or result. <i>He smoothed his hair and adjusted his tie.</i>
align	Align oneself with a group or a way of thinking. <i>All of them must now align against the foe.</i>
<u>alongside</u>	Side by side.
<u>arrange</u>	Arrange thoughts ideas temporal events. <i>I arranged with my boss to have the time off.</i>
<u>array</u>	Display or arrange (things) in a particular way. <i>He was clothed in fine array.</i>
<u>codify</u>	Arrange (laws or rules) into a systematic code. <i>This would codify existing intergovernmental cooperation on drugs.</i>
<u>configuration</u>	An arrangement of parts or elements. <i>The unrepeatable configuration of the stars at the moment of your birth.</i>
deploy	Place troops or weapons in battle formation. <i>The U S deploys its weapons in the Middle East.</i>
dimensional	Having dimension—the quality or character or stature proper to a person. <i>Well rounded fully dimensional characters.</i>
establish	Establish the validity of something as by an example explanation or experiment. <i>Establish the location with a wide shot.</i>
form	Make or be made into a specific shape or form. <i>He filled out his tax form.</i>
harmonize	Bring (several things) into consonance or relate harmoniously. <i>Harmonize one s goals with one s abilities.</i>

horizontally	In a horizontal position or direction. <i>Labels are placed horizontally on the cases.</i>
institute	An association organized to promote art or science or education. <i>A testator who has instituted his daughter heir.</i>
lineation	The act of marking or outlining with lines. <i>Magnetic lineations.</i>
<u>orchestrate</u>	Arrange or score (music) for orchestral performance. <i>The song cycle was stunningly arranged and orchestrated.</i>
ordered	Marked by an orderly, logical, and aesthetically consistent relation of parts. <i>An ordered sequence.</i>
ordering	The act of putting things in a sequential arrangement. <i>There were mistakes in the ordering of items on the list.</i>
organization	An organized structure for arranging or classifying. <i>He was brought in to supervise the organization of a new department.</i>
<u>organize</u>	Bring order and organization to. <i>Organize lessons in a planned way.</i>
<u>planned</u>	Planned in advance. <i>The planned outlays for new equipment.</i>
<u>prepare</u>	To prepare verbally either for written or spoken delivery. <i>She took time off to prepare for her exams.</i>
ready	Make ready or suitable or equip in advance for a particular purpose or for some use event etc. <i>The bridge is ready to collapse.</i>
<u>reconcile</u>	Make (one account) consistent with another, especially by allowing for transactions begun but not yet completed. <i>He was reconciled to leaving.</i>
relocation	The act of changing your residence or place of business. <i>The planned relocation of national headquarters to Warwickshire.</i>
set	Set to a certain position or cause to operate correctly. <i>Set a broken bone.</i>
setup	The way something is organized or arranged. <i>It takes time to learn the setup around here.</i>
sizing	Any glutinous material used to fill pores in surfaces or to stiffen fabrics.
vertically	At right angles to a horizontal plane; aligned in such a way that the top is directly above the bottom. <i>The wheel hangs vertically from a wire.</i>
