Present Tense	<b>coprecipitate / coprecipitates</b>
Past Tense	<b>coprecipitated</b>
Present Participle	<b>coprecipitating</b>
Past Participle	<b>coprecipitated</b>

## **Conjugate Coprecipitate**

**Coprecipitate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>coprecipitate</b>	We <b>coprecipitate</b>
You <b>coprecipitate</b>	You <b>coprecipitate</b>
He/She/It <b>coprecipitates</b>	They <b>coprecipitate</b>

### **Coprecipitate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am coprecipitating</b>	We <b>are coprecipitating</b>
You <b>are coprecipitating</b>	You <b>are coprecipitating</b>
He/She/It <b>is coprecipitating</b>	They <b>are coprecipitating</b>

### **Coprecipitate in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have coprecipitated</b>	We <b>have coprecipitated</b>
You <b>have coprecipitated</b>	You <b>have coprecipitated</b>
He/She/It <b>has coprecipitated</b>	They <b>have coprecipitated</b>

### **Coprecipitate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

I <b>have been coprecipitating</b>	We <b>have been coprecipitating</b>
You <b>have been coprecipitating</b>	You <b>have been coprecipitating</b>
He/She/It <b>has been coprecipitating</b>	They <b>have been coprecipitating</b>

I <b>coprecipitated</b>	We <b>coprecipitated</b>
You <b>coprecipitated</b>	You <b>coprecipitated</b>
He/She/It <b>coprecipitated</b>	They <b>coprecipitated</b>

### **Coprecipitate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I **was coprecipitating**      We **were coprecipitating**  
You **were coprecipitating**      You **were coprecipitating**  
He/She/It **was coprecipitating**      They **were coprecipitating**

**Coprecipitate in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had coprecipitated**      We **had coprecipitated**  
You **had coprecipitated**      You **had coprecipitated**  
He/She/It **had coprecipitated**      They **had coprecipitated**

**Coprecipitate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had been coprecipitating**      We **had been coprecipitating**  
You **had been coprecipitating**      You **had been coprecipitating**  
He/She/It **had been coprecipitating**      They **had been coprecipitating**

**Coprecipitate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will coprecipitate**      We **will coprecipitate**  
You **will coprecipitate**      You **will coprecipitate**  
He/She/It **will coprecipitate**      They **will coprecipitate**

**Coprecipitate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I **will be coprecipitating**      We **will be coprecipitating**  
You **will be coprecipitating**      You **will be coprecipitating**  
He/She/It **will be coprecipitating**      They **will be coprecipitating**

**Coprecipitate in Future Perfect Tense**

**I will have coprecipitated**

**We will have coprecipitated**

**You will have coprecipitated**

**You will have coprecipitated**

**He/She/It will have coprecipitated** **They will have coprecipitated**

**I will have been coprecipitating**

**We will have been coprecipitating**
