## Synonyms of "Copse" as a noun (9 Words)

brake	A device for slowing or stopping a moving vehicle, typically by applying pressure to the wheels. New legislation will put the <b>brake</b> s on spending.
brush	The act of brushing your hair. <i>He gave his hair a quick <b>brush</b>.</i>
brushwood	The wood from bushes or small branches. They built a fire of <b>brushwood</b> .
clump	A small, compact group of people. <i>Clump</i> s of earth.
coppice	An area of woodland in which the trees or shrubs are periodically cut back to ground level to stimulate growth and provide firewood or timber. <i>Coppices of oak were cultivated.</i>
grove	A small wood or other group of trees. An olive <b>grove</b> .



stand	The place where someone typically stands or sits. <i>A bedside <b>stand</b>.</i>
<u>thicket</u>	A dense growth of bushes. A horned owl perfectly camouflaged in a dense <b>thicket</b> .
wood	A golf club with a long shaft used to hit long shots originally made with a wooden head. A long walk in the <b>wood</b> s.
