Synonyms of "Copse" as a noun (9 Words)

brake	A device for slowing or stopping a moving vehicle, typically by applying pressure to the wheels. <i>New legislation will put the brakes on spending.</i>
brush	The act of brushing your hair. <i>He gave his hair a quick brush.</i>
brushwood	The wood from bushes or small branches. <i>They built a fire of brushwood.</i>
clump	A small, compact group of people. <i>Clumps of earth.</i>
coppice	An area of woodland in which the trees or shrubs are periodically cut back to ground level to stimulate growth and provide firewood or timber. <i>Coppices of oak were cultivated.</i>
grove	A small wood or other group of trees. <i>An olive grove.</i>

stand The place where someone typically stands or sits.
*A bedside **stand**.*

thicket A dense growth of bushes.
*A horned owl perfectly camouflaged in a dense **thicket**.*

wood A golf club with a long shaft used to hit long shots originally made with a wooden head.
*A long walk in the **woods**.*
