Definitions of "Copulate" as a verb

According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "copulate" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- Have sexual intercourse.
- Engage in sexual intercourse.





Synonyms of "Copulate" as a verb (4 Words)

Create (fissile material) by nuclear reaction. breed

Pandas rarely **breed** in captivity.

Form a pair or pairs.

The beetles may **couple** up to form a pair.

Place an opponent's king under an attack from which it cannot escape and thus ending the game. mate

Successful males may mate with many females.

Give a member of a legislative assembly another member as a pair to allow both to absent themselves from a vote without affecting the result.

pair Arrangements are usually made between the party whips for an absent member on one side to be **pair**ed with an absentee on the other.





Usage Examples of "Copulate" as a verb

- After about twenty minutes, they copulate again.
- Only the dominant male copulates with the female.
