Copycat as a Noun

Definitions of "Copycat" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “copycat” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *(especially in children's use) a person who copies another's behaviour, dress, or ideas.*
- *Denoting an action, typically a crime, carried out in imitation of another.*
- *Someone who copies the words or behavior of another.*

Synonyms of "Copycat" as a noun (9 Words)

ape	Used in names of macaque monkeys with short tails e g Barbary ape. <i>Cunning is but the ape of wisdom.</i>
aper	Someone who copies the words or behavior of another.
emulator	Someone who copies the words or behavior of another.
imitator	Someone who copies the words or behavior of another. <i>The show s success has sparked off many imitators.</i>
impersonator	A person who pretends to be someone else for entertainment or fraud. <i>A well known Elvis impersonator.</i>
impressionist	A painter who follows the theories of Impressionism.
like	A kind of person. <i>I know him him and his like.</i>

- mimicker** Someone who mimics (especially an actor or actress).
*Syphilis is considered the great **mimicker**.*
- similar** A person or thing similar to another.
*He was one of those whose **similar** you never meet.*
