<u>conform</u>	Adapt or conform oneself to new or different conditions. <i>The kitchen does not conform to hygiene regulations.</i>



conformance	Correspondence in form or appearance. Conformance to international standards.
conforming	Adhering to established customs or doctrines (especially in religion.
<u>consent</u>	Give permission for something to happen. He had consent ed to serve as external assessor on the panel.
<u>exactly</u>	In exact terms; without vagueness. What exactly are you looking for.
fit	Be the right size or shape fit correctly or as desired. A fit subject for discussion.
incidentally	Introducing a different topic; in point of fact. The infection was discovered only incidentally at post mortem examination.
<u>just</u>	Of an opinion or appraisal well founded justifiable. A just and lasting peace.
<u>necessarily</u>	In such a manner as could not be otherwise. It is necessarily so.
obediently	In an obedient manner. She obediently followed the housekeeper s instructions.
obligation	A binding agreement committing a person to a payment or other action. <i>He is under an obligation to finish the job.</i>
ok	Being satisfactory or in satisfactory condition. Things are ok ay.
pertinent	Being of striking appropriateness and pertinence. She asked me a lot of very pertinent questions.
respectively	Separately or individually and in the order already mentioned (used when enumerating two or more items or facts that refer back to a previous statement. <i>The brothers were called Felix and Max respectively.</i>
<u>simultaneous</u>	Occurring or operating at the same time. <i>Simultaneous</i> translation.
simultaneously	, At the same instant. They spoke simultaneously .
together	Self-confident, level-headed, or well organized. <i>They both spoke together</i> .
<u>yes</u>	An affirmative answer or decision, especially in voting. Answering with assured and ardent yes es.
