

<u>refined</u>	Free from what is tawdry or unbecoming. Due to the limitations of the available tools a more <b>refined</b> analysis of the data may be necessary.
<u>seasoned</u>	Aged or processed. <b>Seasoned</b> wood.
<u>sophisticated</u>	Appealing to or frequented by people who are sophisticated. A young man with <b>sophisticated</b> tastes.



<u>suave</u>	Smoothly agreeable and courteous with a degree of sophistication. All the waiters were <b>suave</b> and deferential.

well travelled	In good health especially after having suffered illness or injury.
