Definitions of "Couch" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “couch” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A flat coat of paint or varnish used by artists as a primer.*
- *A long upholstered piece of furniture for several people to sit on.*
- *A narrow bed on which a patient lies during psychiatric or psychoanalytic treatment.*
- *A reclining seat with a headrest at one end on which a psychoanalyst's subject or doctor's patient lies while undergoing treatment.*
- *An upholstered seat for more than one person.*



Synonyms of "Couch" as a noun (9 Words)

chaise longue A long chair; for reclining.

chesterfield A sofa with padded arms and back of the same height and curved outwards at the top.

divan A legislative body, council chamber, or court of justice in the Ottoman Empire or elsewhere in the Middle East.

lounge A public room in a hotel, theatre, or club in which to sit and relax.
*The hotel has a pleasant **lounge** and bar.*

love seat A beloved person; used as terms of endearment.

ottoman A heavy ribbed fabric made from silk and either cotton or wool.

settee A small sofa.

settle A long wooden bench with a back.

sofa A long upholstered seat with a back and arms, for two or more people.
***Sofa** cushions.*



Usage Examples of "Couch" as a noun

- *The child was lying on the examination couch.*
- *I sat in an armchair and they sat on the couch.*



Couch as a Verb

Definitions of "Couch" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "couch" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Lay down.*
- *Treat (a cataract) by pushing the lens of the eye downwards and backwards, out of line with the pupil.*
- *Express (something) in language of a specified style.*
- *Formulate in a particular style or language.*
- *Lower (a spear) to the position for attack.*
- *(in embroidery) fix (a thread) to a fabric by stitching it down flat with another thread.*



Synonyms of "Couch" as a verb (18 Words)

cast

Form by pouring e g wax or hot metal into a cast or mold.
*When hammered or **cast** bronze could be made into tools.*

communicate

Transmit (heat or motion).
***Communicate** a disease.*

convey

Transfer the title to (property).
*The real virtues and diversity of America had never been **conveyed** in the movies.*

express

Give expression to.
*She **expressed** her anger.*

formulate

Create or prepare methodically.
*He **formulated** his concerns to the board of trustees.*

frame	Enclose in or as if in a frame. <i>He claims he was framed.</i>
phrase	Divide music into phrases in a particular way especially in performance. <i>They phrased the music with gusto.</i>
put	Put into a certain place or abstract location. <i>Estimates put the war's cost at 1 million a day.</i>
put across	Cause (someone) to undergo something.
redact	Formulate in a particular style or language. <i>A confidential memo which has been redacted from 25 pages to just one paragraph.</i>
render	Give up surrender. <i>He will render up his immortal soul.</i>
say	Express a supposition. <i>Did his face say anything about how he felt.</i>
set forth	Set in type.
state	Express in words. <i>The report stated that more than 51 per cent of voters failed to participate.</i>
style	Make consistent with certain rules of style. <i>The official is styled principal and vice chancellor of the university.</i>
utter	Express audibly utter sounds not necessarily words. <i>Utter counterfeit currency.</i>
voice	Give voice to. <i>He is unable to voice the g sound.</i>
word	Put into words or an expression. <i>A strongly worded letter of protest.</i>



Usage Examples of "Couch" as a verb

- *Gold and silver threads couched by hand.*
- *Two fair creatures, couched side by side in deepest grass.*
- *There were few problems of double vision in patients who had been couched for cataracts.*
- *The assurances were couched in general terms.*
- *To arms! cried Mortimer, and couch'd his quiv'ring lance.*
- *Cataracts, when simple, are to be couched.*



Associations of "Couch" (30 Words)

- armchair** Chair with a support on each side for arms.
*An **armchair** traveller.*
- bed** A place on the seabed where shellfish especially oysters or mussels breed or are bred.
*The room had only a **bed** and chair.*
- bedspread** Decorative cover for a bed.
- bookcase** An open cabinet containing shelves on which to keep books.
- brocade** Thick heavy expensive material with a raised pattern.
*A heavy **brocade** curtain.*
- cafeteria** A restaurant where you serve yourself and pay a cashier.
*Employers who offer **cafeteria** plans and other flexible programs.*

<u>chair</u>	The person in charge of a meeting or of an organization used as a neutral alternative to chairman or chairwoman. <i>He is second chair violin.</i>
corridor	A passage along the side of some railway carriages, from which doors lead into compartments. <i>The security forces established corridors for humanitarian supplies.</i>
cupboard	A small room (or recess) or cabinet used for storage space. <i>A broom cupboard.</i>
curtain	Conceal or screen with a curtain. <i>It looked like curtains for me.</i>
<u>cushion</u>	A soft bag filled with air or a mass of padding such as feathers or foam rubber etc. <i>Comfortable chairs and sofas piled with cushions.</i>
desk	A specified section of a newspaper or broadcasting organization. <i>He landed a job on the sports desk.</i>
fridge	A refrigerator. <i>She put the carton of milk back in the fridge.</i>
furnishing	The instrumentalities (furniture and appliances and other movable accessories including curtains and rugs) that make a home (or other area) livable. <i>A large room filled with fine ornaments and luxurious furnishings.</i>
<u>furniture</u>	The movable articles that are used to make a room or building suitable for living or working in, such as tables, chairs, or desks. <i>There was only one piece of furniture in the room.</i>
<u>lay</u>	Lay eggs. <i>The lay ministry.</i>
leather	Whip with a leather strap. <i>He caught me and leathered me black and blue.</i>
<u>lounge</u>	Be about. <i>The hotel has a pleasant lounge and bar.</i>
pillow	Rest one's head as if on a pillow. <i>Her transparent cheek all pale and warm pillow d his deathlike forehead.</i>
<u>posture</u>	Assume a posture as for artistic purposes. <i>Stood with good posture.</i>
recline	Cause to recline. <i>He tried to recline his seat.</i>
recliner	A chair with a reclining back, especially one with an integral footrest.

recumbent	Lying down; in a position of comfort or rest. Recumbent statues.
repose	Harmonious arrangement of colours and forms, providing a restful visual effect. <i>He had lost none of his grace or his repose.</i>
rest	Not move be in a resting position. Rest assured.
seat	Of a vehicle or building have seats for a specified number of people. <i>There were not enough seats for all the guests.</i>
slouch	Stand, move, or sit in a lazy, drooping way. <i>He s no slouch when it comes to baseball.</i>
sofa	A long upholstered seat with a back and arms, for two or more people. Sofa cushions.
stool	Lure with a stool as of wild fowl. <i>Fibre in the child s diet will soften the stools.</i>
toilet	A room building or cubicle containing a toilet or toilets. <i>A bathroom cabinet stocked with toilet articles.</i>
