### Definitions of "Couch" as a noun

- *A flat coat of paint or varnish used by artists as a primer.*
- *A long upholstered piece of furniture for several people to sit on.*
- *A narrow bed on which a patient lies during psychiatric or psychoanalytic treatment.*
- *A reclining seat with a headrest at one end on which a psychoanalyst's subject or doctor's patient lies while undergoing treatment.*
- *An upholstered seat for more than one person.*



## Synonyms of "Couch" as a noun (9 Words)

**chaise longue** A long chair; for reclining.

**chesterfield** A sofa with padded arms and back of the same height and curved outwards at the top.

**divan** A legislative body, council chamber, or court of justice in the Ottoman Empire or elsewhere in the Middle East.

**lounge** A public room in a hotel, theatre, or club in which to sit and relax.  
*The hotel has a pleasant **lounge** and bar.*

**love seat** A beloved person; used as terms of endearment.

**ottoman** A heavy ribbed fabric made from silk and either cotton or wool.

**settee** A small sofa.

**settle** A long wooden bench with a back.

**sofa** A long upholstered seat with a back and arms, for two or more people.  
***Sofa** cushions.*

## Couch as a Verb

### Definitions of "Couch" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "couch" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Lay down.*
- *Treat (a cataract) by pushing the lens of the eye downwards and backwards, out of line with the pupil.*
- *Express (something) in language of a specified style.*
- *Formulate in a particular style or language.*
- *Lower (a spear) to the position for attack.*
- *(in embroidery) fix (a thread) to a fabric by stitching it down flat with another thread.*





## Synonyms of "Couch" as a verb (18 Words)

### cast

Form by pouring e g wax or hot metal into a cast or mold.  
*When hammered or **cast** bronze could be made into tools.*

### **communicate**

Transmit (heat or motion).  
***Communicate** a disease.*

### convey

Transfer the title to (property).  
*The real virtues and diversity of America had never been **conveyed** in the movies.*

### **express**

Give expression to.  
*She **expressed** her anger.*

### formulate

Create or prepare methodically.  
*He **formulated** his concerns to the board of trustees.*

<b>frame</b>	Enclose in or as if in a frame. <i>He claims he was <b>framed</b>.</i>
<b>phrase</b>	Divide music into phrases in a particular way especially in performance. <i>They <b>phrased</b> the music with gusto.</i>
<b>put</b>	Put into a certain place or abstract location. <i>Estimates <b>put</b> the war s cost at 1 million a day.</i>
<b>put across</b>	Cause (someone) to undergo something.
<b>redact</b>	Formulate in a particular style or language. <i>A confidential memo which has been <b>redacted</b> from 25 pages to just one paragraph.</i>
<b>render</b>	Give up surrender. <i>He will <b>render</b> up his immortal soul.</i>
<b>say</b>	Express a supposition. <i>Did his face <b>say</b> anything about how he felt.</i>
<b>set forth</b>	Set in type.
<b>state</b>	Express in words. <i>The report <b>stated</b> that more than 51 per cent of voters failed to participate.</i>
<b>style</b>	Make consistent with certain rules of style. <i>The official is <b>styled</b> principal and vice chancellor of the university.</i>
<b>utter</b>	Express audibly utter sounds not necessarily words. <i><b>Utter</b> counterfeit currency.</i>
<b>voice</b>	Give voice to. <i>He is unable to <b>voice</b> the g sound.</i>
<b>word</b>	Put into words or an expression. <i>A strongly <b>worded</b> letter of protest.</i>





## Usage Examples of "Couch" as a verb

- *Gold and silver threads couched by hand.*
- *Two fair creatures, couched side by side in deepest grass.*
- *There were few problems of double vision in patients who had been couched for cataracts.*
- *The assurances were couched in general terms.*
- *To arms! cried Mortimer, and couch'd his quiv'ring lance.*
- *Cataracts, when simple, are to be couched.*

- armchair** Chair with a support on each side for arms.  
*An **armchair** traveller.*
- bed** A place on the seabed where shellfish especially oysters or mussels breed or are bred.  
*The room had only a **bed** and chair.*
- bedspread** Decorative cover for a bed.
- bookcase** An open cabinet containing shelves on which to keep books.
- brocade** Thick heavy expensive material with a raised pattern.

<b><u>chair</u></b>	The person in charge of a meeting or of an organization used as a neutral alternative to chairman or chairwoman. <i>He is second <b>chair</b> violin.</i>
<b>corridor</b>	A passage along the side of some railway carriages, from which doors lead into compartments. <i>The security forces established <b>corridors</b> for humanitarian supplies.</i>
<b>cupboard</b>	A small room (or recess) or cabinet used for storage space. <i>A broom <b>cupboard</b>.</i>
<b>curtain</b>	Conceal or screen with a curtain. <i>It looked like <b>curtains</b> for me.</i>
<b><u>cushion</u></b>	A soft bag filled with air or a mass of padding such as feathers or foam rubber etc. <i>Comfortable chairs and sofas piled with <b>cushions</b>.</i>
<b>desk</b>	A specified section of a newspaper or broadcasting organization. <i>He landed a job on the sports <b>desk</b>.</i>
<b>fridge</b>	A refrigerator. <i>She put the carton of milk back in the <b>fridge</b>.</i>
<b>furnishing</b>	The instrumentalities (furniture and appliances and other movable accessories including curtains and rugs) that make a home (or other area) livable. <i>A large room filled with fine ornaments and luxurious <b>furnishings</b>.</i>
<b><u>furniture</u></b>	The movable articles that are used to make a room or building suitable for living or working in, such as tables, chairs, or desks. <i>There was only one piece of <b>furniture</b> in the room.</i>
<b><u>lay</u></b>	Lay eggs. <i>The <b>lay</b> ministry.</i>
<b>leather</b>	Whip with a leather strap. <i>He caught me and <b>leathered</b> me black and blue.</i>
<b><u>lounge</u></b>	Be about. <i>The hotel has a pleasant <b>lounge</b> and bar.</i>
<b>pillow</b>	Rest one's head as if on a pillow. <i>Her transparent cheek all pale and warm <b>pillow</b> d his deathlike forehead.</i>
<b><u>posture</u></b>	Assume a posture as for artistic purposes. <i>Stood with good <b>posture</b>.</i>
<b>recline</b>	Cause to recline. <i>He tried to <b>recline</b> his seat.</i>
<b>recliner</b>	A chair with a reclining back, especially one with an integral footrest.

- recumbent** Lying down; in a position of comfort or rest.  
***Recumbent** statues.*
- repose** Harmonious arrangement of colours and forms, providing a restful visual effect.  
*He had lost none of his grace or his **repose**.*
- rest** Not move be in a resting position.  
***Rest** assured.*
- seat** Of a vehicle or building have seats for a specified number of people.  
*There were not enough **seats** for all the guests.*
- slouch** Stand, move, or sit in a lazy, drooping way.  
*He s no **slouch** when it comes to baseball.*
- sofa** A long upholstered seat with a back and arms, for two or more people.  
***Sofa** cushions.*
- stool** Lure with a stool as of wild fowl.  
*Fibre in the child s diet will soften the **stools**.*
- toilet** A room building or cubicle containing a toilet or toilets.  
*A bathroom cabinet stocked with **toilet** articles.*
