Counsel in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am counselling or counseling
You are counselling or counseling
He/She/It is counselling or counseling
They are counselling or counseling
You are counselling or counseling

Counsel in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have counselled or counseled
You have counselled or counseled
He/She/It has counselled or counseled
They have counselled or counseled
You have counselled or counseled

Counsel in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been counselling or counseling
You have been counselling or counseling
He/She/It has been counselling or
counseling
They have been counselling or
counseling
They have been counselling or
counseling

Counsel in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I counselled or counseled
You counselled or counseled
He/She/It counselled or counseled
They counselled or counseled



Counsel in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I was counselling or counseling
You were counselling or counseling
He/She/It was counselling or counseling
They were counselling or counseling

Counsel in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had counselled or counseled
You had counselled or counseled
He/She/It had counselled or counseled
They had counselled or counseled
We had counselled or counseled
You had counselled or counseled

Counsel in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been counselling or counseling
You had been counselling or counseling
He/She/It had been counselling or

We had been counselling or counselling
You had been counselling or counselling
He/She/It had been counselling or

They had been counselling or counseling

Counsel in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will counsel
You will counsel
He/She/It will counsel
They will counsel

Counsel in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be counselling or counseling
You will be counselling or counseling
You will be counselling or counseling
You will be counselling or counseling

He/She/It will be counselling or counseling They will be counselling or counseling



Counsel in Future Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I will have counselled or counseled
You will have counselled or counseled
You will have counselled or counseled
You will have counselled or counseled

He/She/It will have counselled or counseled They will have counselled or counseled

Counsel in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been counselling or counseling or counseling counseling

You will have been counselling or You will have been counselling or

counseling counseling

He/She/It will have been counselling or They will have been counselling or

counseling counseling
