Counterpose in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I **counterpose**You **counterpose**He/She/It **counterposes** They **counterpose**

Counterpose in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am counterposing We are counterposing
You are counterposing You are counterposing
He/She/It is counterposing They are counterposing

Counterpose in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have counterposed We have counterposed You have counterposed He/She/It has counterposed They have counterposed

Counterpose in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been counterposing

You have been counterposing

You have been counterposing

He/She/It has been counterposing

They have been counterposing

Counterpose in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **counterposed** We **counterposed**You **counterposed** You **counterposed**He/She/It **counterposed** They **counterposed**

Counterpose in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was counterposing We were counterposing
You were counterposing
He/She/It was counterposing They were counterposing

Counterpose in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had counterposed We had counterposed
You had counterposed You had counterposed
He/She/It had counterposed They had counterposed

Counterpose in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been counterposing
You had been counterposing
He/She/It had been counterposing
They had been counterposing

Counterpose in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will counterpose
You will counterpose
He/She/It will counterpose
They will counterpose

Counterpose in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be counterposing
You will be counterposing
He/She/It will be counterposing
They will be counterposing

Counterpose in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have counterposed We will have counterposed You will have counterposed He/She/It will have counterposed They will have counterposed

Counterpose in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been counterposing
You will have been counterposing
He/She/It will have been counterposing
They will have been counterposing
