# **Conjugate Course**

#### **Course in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I course	We course
You <b>course</b>	You <b>course</b>
He/She/It courses	They course

### **Course in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am coursing	We are coursing
You <b>are coursing</b>	You <b>are coursing</b>
He/She/It is coursing	They are coursing

#### **Course in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have coursed	We have coursed
You have coursed	You have coursed
He/She/It has coursed	They have coursed

### **Course in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been coursing	We have been coursing
You have been coursing	You have been coursing
He/She/It has been coursing	They have been coursing

### **Course in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I coursed	We <b>coursed</b>
You <b>coursed</b>	You <b>coursed</b>
He/She/It <b>coursed</b>	They $\ensuremath{\textbf{coursed}}$

### **Course in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was coursing	We were coursing
You were coursing	You were coursing
He/She/It was coursing	They were coursing

#### **Course in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had coursed	We had coursed
You had coursed	You had coursed
He/She/It had coursed	They had coursed

### **Course in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been coursing	We had been coursing
You had been coursing	You had been coursing
He/She/It had been coursing	They had been coursing

### **Course in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will course	We will course
You <b>will course</b>	You <b>will course</b>
He/She/It will course	They will course

### **Course in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be coursing	We will be coursing
You <b>will be coursing</b>	You will be coursing
He/She/It will be coursing	They will be coursing

#### **Course in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been coursing	We <b>will have been coursing</b>
You <b>will have been coursing</b>	You will have been coursing
He/She/It will have been coursing	They will have been coursing
