artfully	In a manner that shows creative skill or taste. <i>Body scanners are turning up artfully concealed items.</i>
chocolate	Hot chocolate. <i>His chocolate brown eyes.</i>
cloud	Make overcast or cloudy. <i>The stroke clouded memories of her youth.</i>
conceal	Hold back; keep from being perceived by others. <i>She conceals her anger well.</i>
concealed	Hidden on any grounds for any motive. <i>He spoke with barely concealed anger.</i>
conspire	Make secret plans jointly to commit an unlawful or harmful act. <i>They conspired to overthrow the government.</i>
damp	Damp air or atmosphere. <i>The sudden bad news damped the joyous atmosphere.</i>
drenched	Abundantly covered or supplied with; often used in combination. <i>Moon drenched meadows.</i>
dusty	Staid and uninteresting. <i>Dusty old records.</i>
eavesdrop	Secretly listen to a conversation. <i>The jealous man was eavesdropping on his wife s conversations.</i>
hidden	Not accessible to view. <i>Hidden dangers.</i>
hide	Be or go into hiding; keep out of sight, as for protection and safety. <i>Herbert could hardly hide his dislike.</i>
indistinct	Not clearly defined or easy to perceive or understand. <i>His speech was slurred and indistinct.</i>

<u>invisible</u>	Invisible exports and imports. <i>Invisible exports.</i>
moisturize	Make (more) humid. <i>Revitalize your face moisturize your skin.</i>
muddy	Cause to become muddy. <i>The original colours were blurred into muddy pink and yellow.</i>
<u>muffled</u>	(of a sound) not loud because of being obstructed in some way; muted. <i>Muffled drums.</i>
muted	(of colour or lighting) not bright; subdued. <i>A dress in muted tones of powder blue and dusty pink.</i>
<u>privacy</u>	The state of being free from public attention. <i>She returned to the privacy of her own home.</i>
rain	Falls of rain. <i>If it rains much more we can expect some flooding.</i>
<u>secrecy</u>	The action of keeping something secret or the state of being kept secret. <i>The bidding is conducted in secrecy.</i>
secretly	In a secret way; without others knowing. <i>Met secretly to discuss the invasion plans.</i>
slyly	In a way that suggests some secret knowledge that may be harmful or embarrassing; knowingly. <i>He slyly manipulates votes.</i>
snow	Falls of snow. <i>It was snowing all night.</i>
snowy	Of the white color of snow. <i>Snowy hair.</i>
stealth	Avoiding detection by moving carefully. <i>Privatization by stealth.</i>
stealthily	In a cautious and surreptitious manner, so as not to be seen or heard. <i>I woke up and stealthily crept downstairs.</i>
tropics	The part of the Earth's surface between the Tropic of Cancer and the Tropic of Capricorn; characterized by a hot climate.
<u>wet</u>	Wetness caused by water. <i>A wet cow.</i>
white	A white thing in particular the white ball the cue ball in snooker or billiards. <i>A bride s white dress.</i>
