## Associations of "Crack down" (30 Words)

<a href="#">abyss</a>	A catastrophic situation seen as likely to occur. <i>The <b>abyss</b> between the two nations.</i>
<b>aperture</b>	A device that controls amount of light admitted. <i>The bell ropes passed through <b>apertures</b> in the ceiling.</i>
<b>bifocal</b>	A pair of glasses with bifocal lenses. <i><b>Bifocal</b> eyeglasses.</i>
<b>bifurcated</b>	Divided into or made up of two parts. <i>Socially <b>bifurcated</b> populations.</i>
<b>break</b>	Become fractured break or crack on the surface only. <i>I was acting as referee and telling them to <b>break</b>.</i>
<b>cleavage</b>	The act of cleaving or splitting. <i>Holly and Bridget checked their <b>cleavages</b> and rearranged their hair.</i>
<b>cleft</b>	Split or divided. <i>A <b>cleft</b> chin.</i>
<a href="#">collapse</a>	Collapse due to fatigue an illness or a sudden attack. <i>Some cots <b>collapse</b> down to fit into a holdall.</i>
<a href="#">crevice</a>	A long narrow opening. <i>Many creatures hide in <b>crevices</b> in the rock.</i>
<b>descending</b>	Coming down or downward. <i>A rocky <b>descending</b> path.</i>
<a href="#">differential</a>	An infinitesimal difference between successive values of a variable. <i>The <b>differential</b> features between benign and malignant tumours.</i>
<b>differentiate</b>	Evolve so as to lead to a new species or develop in a way most suited to the environment. <i>Little now <b>differentiates</b> the firm s products from its rivals.</i>

<b>disjunction</b>	The act of breaking a connection. <i>There is a <b>disjunction</b> between the skills taught in education and those demanded in the labour market.</i>
<b>distinction</b>	A discrimination between things as different and distinct on the basis of their characteristics or attributes. <i>She graduated with the highest <b>distinction</b>.</i>
<b>diverge</b>	Develop in a different direction. <i>The coverage by the columnists <b>diverged</b> from that in the main news stories.</i>
<b>divergent</b>	Diverging from another or from a standard. <i><b>Divergent</b> thinking.</i>
<b>divide</b>	Force, take, or pull apart. <i>3 <b>divides</b> into 15.</i>
<b>divided</b>	Distributed in portions (often equal) on the basis of a plan or purpose. <i>A <b>divided</b> party leadership.</i>
<b>falling</b>	Coming down freely under the influence of gravity. <i><b>Falling</b> temperatures.</i>
<b>fissure</b>	Break into fissures or fine cracks. <i>The bacteria survive around vents or <b>fissures</b> in the deep ocean floor.</i>
<b>flop</b>	With a flopping sound. <i>He landed on the bed with a great <b>flop</b>.</i>
<b>gap</b>	Make an opening or gap in. <i>The explosion made a <b>gap</b> in the wall.</i>
<b>incised</b>	Cut or impressed into a surface. <i>An <b>incised</b> design.</i>
<b>interstice</b>	A small structural space between tissues or parts of an organ. <i>The <b>interstices</b> of a network.</i>
<b>partible</b>	Involving or denoting a system of inheritance in which a deceased person's estate is divided equally among the heirs. <i>The entire family lost status as a consequence of <b>partible</b> inheritance.</i>
<b>rupture</b>	The act of making a sudden noisy break. <i>One of the boys was <b>ruptured</b> and needed to be fitted with a truss.</i>
<b>separated</b>	Separated at the joint. <i>A <b>separated</b> shoulder.</i>
<b>snap</b>	A card game in which cards from two piles are turned over simultaneously and players call snap as quickly as possible when two similar cards are exposed. <i><b>Snap</b> your fingers.</i>
