Definitions of "Craftsman" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “craftsman” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A professional whose work is consistently of high quality.*
- *A creator of great skill in the manual arts.*
- *A skilled worker who practices some trade or handicraft.*
- *(in the UK) a qualified private soldier in the Royal Electrical and Mechanical Engineers.*
- *A worker skilled in a particular craft.*



Synonyms of "Craftsman" as a noun (13 Words)

artificer	An enlisted man responsible for the upkeep of small arms and machine guns etc.
<u>artisan</u>	(of food or drink) made in a traditional or non-mechanized way using high-quality ingredients. <i>Britain's artisan cheeses.</i>
crafter	A creator of great skill in the manual arts.
craftsperson	A person who is skilled at making things by hand (used as a neutral alternative).
<u>journeyman</u>	A skilled worker who practices some trade or handicraft. <i>A journeyman carpenter.</i>
maker	A business engaged in manufacturing some product. <i>Makers of rubber products.</i>
<u>mechanic</u>	A manual labourer or artisan. <i>A car mechanic.</i>

operative	Someone who can be employed as a detective to collect information. <i>The operatives clean the machines at the end of every shift.</i>
smith	Religious leader who founded the Mormon Church in 1830 (1805-1844). <i>We do not know whether the metals were mined and smelted by the smith or purchased from miners.</i>
technician	Someone known for high skill in some intellectual or artistic technique. <i>Liszt was one of the greatest piano technicians of all time.</i>
tradesman	A merchant who owns or manages a shop.
tradesperson	A person engaged in trading or a trade, typically on a relatively small scale. <i>A reputable tradesperson.</i>
wright	United States writer of detective novels (1888-1939).



Usage Examples of "Craftsman" as a noun

- *Those craftsmen of post-war fiction.*
- *The tiles are handmade by trained craftsmen.*
- *Craftsman Browne.*

- *As an actor he was a consummate craftsman.*



Associations of "Craftsman" (30 Words)

adept	Someone who is dazzlingly skilled in any field. <i>He is an adept at imitation.</i>
adroit	Quick or skillful or adept in action or thought. <i>An adroit negotiator.</i>
<u>artisan</u>	A worker in a skilled trade, especially one that involves making things by hand. <i>Britain's artisan cheeses.</i>
bricklayer	A craftsman skilled in building with bricks.
<u>builder</u>	A person whose job is to construct or repair houses. <i>Empire builder.</i>

<u>carpenter</u>	Do the work of a carpenter. <i>The rails were carpentered very skilfully.</i>
competence	The legal authority of a court or other body to deal with a particular matter. <i>He found himself with an ample competence and no obligations.</i>
competent	(of a court or other body) accepted as having legal authority to deal with a particular matter. <i>The London Stock Exchange is the competent authority under the Financial Services Act.</i>
<u>craft</u>	An aircraft or spaceship. <i>A beautifully crafted object.</i>
dexterous	Skillful in physical movements; especially of the hands. <i>A dexterous keyboard player.</i>
experienced	Having experience; having knowledge or skill from observation or participation. <i>An experienced social worker.</i>
expert	A person with special knowledge or ability who performs skillfully. <i>An expert in healthcare.</i>
handcraft	Make something by hand. <i>We handcraft all our paper.</i>
handmade	Made by hand, not by machine, and typically therefore of superior quality. <i>His expensive handmade leather shoes.</i>
mason	A Freemason. <i>The chief mason at Westminster Abbey.</i>
master	Make a master copy of a film or recording. <i>In many ways dogs reflect the styles of their masters.</i>
<u>masterful</u>	Powerful and able to control others. <i>Masterful technique.</i>
plumber	A craftsman who installs and repairs pipes and fixtures and appliances.
practiced	Having or showing knowledge and skill and aptitude. <i>A practiced marksman.</i>
proficiency	Skillfulness in the command of fundamentals deriving from practice and familiarity. <i>Practice greatly improves proficiency.</i>
proficient	A person who is proficient. <i>A proficient engineer.</i>
repairman	A skilled worker whose job is to repair things. <i>A TV repairman.</i>

seasoned	(of food) having had salt, pepper, herbs, or spices added. <i>A seasoned traveler.</i>
skilled	(of work) requiring special abilities or training. <i>A skilled trade.</i>
skillful	Done with delicacy and skill. <i>The effect was achieved by skillful retouching.</i>
tanner	A small coin of the United Kingdom worth six pennies; not minted since 1970. <i>Skincare companies are coming to the rescue of consumers with sunless tanners.</i>
technician	A person skilled in the technique of an art or craft. <i>Liszt was one of the greatest piano technicians of all time.</i>
veteran	A serviceman who has seen considerable active service. <i>A veteran of two world wars.</i>
weaver	A songbird of tropical Africa and Asia, related to the sparrows and building elaborately woven nests.
workmanlike	Worthy of a good workman. <i>The book is a workmanlike job with chronology and bibliography and index.</i>
