# **Conjugate Creak**

## **Creak in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>creak</b>	We <b>creak</b>
You <b>creak</b>	You <b>creak</b>
He/She/It creaks	They creak

## **Creak in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am creaking	We are creaking
You <b>are creaking</b>	You <b>are creaking</b>
He/She/It is creaking	They are creaking

### **Creak in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have creaked	We have creaked
You have creaked	You have creaked
He/She/It has creaked	They have creaked

## **Creak in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been creaking	We have been creaking
You <b>have been creaking</b>	You have been creaking
He/She/It has been creaking	They have been creaking

## **Creak in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I creaked	We <b>creaked</b>
You <b>creaked</b>	You <b>creaked</b>
He/She/It creaked	They <b>creaked</b>

## **Creak in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was creaking	We <b>were creaking</b>
You <b>were creaking</b>	You were creaking
He/She/It was creaking	They were creaking

#### **Creak in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had creaked	We had creaked
You had creaked	You had creaked
He/She/It had creaked	They had creaked

## **Creak in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been creaking	We had been creaking
You <b>had been creaking</b>	You had been creaking
He/She/It had been creaking	They had been creaking

## **Creak in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will creak	We <b>will creak</b>
You <b>will creak</b>	You <b>will creak</b>
He/She/It will creak	They will creak

## **Creak in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be creaking	We <b>will be creaking</b>
You <b>will be creaking</b>	You <b>will be creaking</b>
He/She/It will be creaking	They will be creaking
