god almighty	Any supernatural being worshipped as controlling some part of the world or some aspect of life or who is the personification of a force.
godhead	A greatly admired or influential person. <i>There on a skateboard was America s current godhead.</i>
<u>inventor</u>	A person who invented a particular process or device or who invents things as an occupation.
jehovah	A name for the God of the Old Testament as transliterated from the Hebrew consonants YHVH.
<u>lord</u>	(in the UK) a courtesy title given to a younger son of a duke or marquess (prefixed to a Christian name). <i>Our lord the king.</i>
maker	A business engaged in manufacturing some product. <i>Makers of rubber products.</i>
producer	Something that produces. <i>He s the executive producer of weekday daytime shows.</i>
the almighty	Terms referring to the Judeo-Christian God.
the lord	A titled peer of the realm.
the master of the universe	An original creation (i.e., an audio recording) from which copies can be made.
<u>writer</u>	A person who writes books, stories, or articles as a job or occupation. <i>A CD writer.</i>

godly	Showing great reverence for god. <i>How to live the godly life.</i>
hallowed	Made holy; consecrated. <i>The hallowed turf of Wimbledon.</i>
<u>heavenly</u>	Of or belonging to heaven or god. <i>It was a heavenly morning for a ride.</i>
kingship	The state or position of being a king. <i>Upon his succession to the kingship David retained his English estates.</i>
liturgy	A religious service conducted according to a liturgy. <i>At the conclusion of the liturgy the Bishop presented the certificates.</i>
<u>lord</u>	Make a lord of someone. <i>Sir Cadwallader Pleadwell has been lately lorded.</i>
maker	A business engaged in manufacturing some product. <i>Makers of rubber products.</i>
mighty	(Southern regional intensive) very; to a great degree. <i>A mighty 450.</i>
omnipotence	The quality of having unlimited or very great power. <i>God s omnipotence.</i>
omnipotent	Having unlimited power. <i>An omnipotent sovereign.</i>
omniscience	The state of knowing everything. <i>The notion of divine omniscience.</i>
<u>omniscient</u>	Infinitely wise. <i>A third person omniscient narrator.</i>
orison	A prayer.
sacred	Worthy of respect or dedication. <i>Cows are sacred and the eating of beef is taboo.</i>

<u>sanctity</u>	The state or quality of being holy, sacred, or saintly. <i>The site of the tomb was a place of sanctity for the ancient Egyptians.</i>
superhuman	Having or showing exceptional ability or powers. <i>Superhuman strength.</i>
supernal	Relating to the sky or the heavens; celestial. <i>He is the supernal poet of our age.</i>
<u>worship</u>	The activity of worshipping. <i>The family worshipped at Trinity Church.</i>
