<b>aforesaid</b>	Being the one previously mentioned or spoken of.
<b><a href="#">allusion</a></b>	The practice of making allusions. <i>A classical <b>allusion</b>.</i>
<b>annotation</b>	A note by way of explanation or comment added to a text or diagram. <i>Marginal <b>annotations</b>.</i>
<b><a href="#">article</a></b>	The definite or indefinite article. <i>It may be worth taking <b>articles</b> in a specialized firm.</i>
<b><a href="#">barn</a></b>	A unit of nuclear cross section; the effective circular area that one particle presents to another as a target for an encounter. <i>A great <b>barn</b> of a pub.</i>
<b>catalog</b>	Make an itemized list or catalog of classify. <i>It does not pretend to be a <b>catalog</b> of his achievements.</i>
<b>catalogue</b>	Enter an item in a catalogue. <i>The report <b>catalogues</b> dangerous work practices in the company.</i>
<b>cereal</b>	Foodstuff prepared from the starchy grains of cereal grasses. <i>A bowl of <b>cereal</b>.</i>
<b>citation</b>	A passage or expression that is quoted or cited. <i>This journal contains <b>citations</b> from all jurisdictions.</i>
<b><a href="#">cite</a></b>	Praise (someone, typically a member of the armed forces) in an official report for a courageous act. <i>He was <b>cited</b> for his outstanding achievements.</i>
<b><a href="#">denote</a></b>	Be a sign of; indicate. <i>The level of output per firm is <b>denoted</b> by X.</i>
<b>diary</b>	A book with spaces for each day of the year in which one notes appointments or information. <i>The City <b>Diary</b>.</i>

<b>grain</b>	1 7000 pound equals a troy grain or 64 799 milligrams. <i>A few <b>grains</b> of corn.</i>
<b>granary</b>	A storehouse for threshed grain or animal feed.
<b>hay</b>	Convert plant material into hay. <i>The grass had all <b>hayed</b> off and gone to seed.</i>
<b>journal</b>	Write in a journal or diary. <i>He reads the medical <b>journals</b>.</i>
<b>label</b>	Attach a label to something. <i>The alcohol content is clearly stated on the <b>label</b>.</i>
<b>list</b>	Include or enter in a list. <i>I <b>listed</b> myself for a soldier.</i>
<b>manger</b>	A long trough from which horses or cattle feed.
<b>memo</b>	A memorandum.
<b>memorandum</b>	A document recording the terms of a contract or other legal details. <i>The two countries signed a <b>memorandum</b> of understanding on economic cooperation.</i>
<b>mention</b>	Make mention of. <i>She made frequent <b>mention</b> of her promotion.</i>
<b>notebook</b>	A book with blank pages for recording notes or memoranda. <i>He copied the number into his <b>notebook</b>.</i>
<b>outhouse</b>	A small outbuilding with a bench having holes through which a user can defecate. <i>Books <b>outhoused</b> in the annex take longer to deliver.</i>
<b>quote</b>	Put quote marks around. <i>The examples <b>quoted</b> above could be multiplied from case studies from all over England.</i>
<b>reference</b>	An indicator that orients you generally. <i><b>References</b> to Darwinism and evolution.</i>
<b>remark</b>	Explicit notice. <i>It passed without <b>remark</b>.</i>
<b>report</b>	An employee who reports to another employee. <i><b>Report</b> has it that the beetles have now virtually disappeared.</i>
<b>repute</b>	Be generally regarded to be or as being (but not definitely the case). <i>He is <b>reputed</b> to be intelligent.</i>
<b>straw</b>	Of a pale yellow color like straw straw colored. <i>Cows were <b>strawed</b> to weather the snowstorm.</i>
