# **Conjugate Crick**

## **Crick in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I crick	We crick
You <b>crick</b>	You <b>crick</b>
He/She/It cricks	They crick

## **Crick in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am cricking	We are cricking
You <b>are cricking</b>	You <b>are cricking</b>
He/She/It is cricking	They are cricking

#### **Crick in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have cricked	We have cricked
You have cricked	You have cricked
He/She/It has cricked	They have cricked

#### **Crick in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been cricking	We have been cricking
You <b>have been cricking</b>	You have been cricking
He/She/It has been cricking	They have been cricking

## **Crick in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I cricked	We <b>cricked</b>
You <b>cricked</b>	You <b>cricked</b>
He/She/It <b>cricked</b>	They <b>cricked</b>

## **Crick in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was cricking	We were cricking
You <b>were cricking</b>	You were cricking
He/She/It was cricking	They were cricking

#### **Crick in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had cricked	We had cricked
You <b>had cricked</b>	You <b>had cricked</b>
He/She/It had cricked	They had cricked

## **Crick in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been cricking	We had been cricking
You <b>had been cricking</b>	You had been cricking
He/She/It had been cricking	They had been cricking

## **Crick in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will crick	We will crick
You <b>will crick</b>	You <b>will crick</b>
He/She/It will crick They will crick	

## **Crick in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be cricking	We <b>will be cricking</b>
You <b>will be cricking</b>	You <b>will be cricking</b>
He/She/It will be cricking	They will be cricking

Singular	Plural
I will have been cricking	We <b>will have been cricking</b>
You <b>will have been cricking</b>	You <b>will have been cricking</b>
He/She/It will have been cricking	They will have been cricking
