Conjugate Criminalise

Criminalise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I **criminalise**You **criminalise**He/She/It **criminalises** They **criminalise**

Criminalise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am criminalising We are criminalising
You are criminalising You are criminalising
He/She/It is criminalising They are criminalising

Criminalise in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have criminalised We have criminalised You have criminalised He/She/It has criminalised They have criminalised

Criminalise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been criminalising
You have been criminalising
He/She/It has been criminalising
They have been criminalising

Criminalise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **criminalised** We **criminalised**You **criminalised** You **criminalised**He/She/It **criminalised** They **criminalised**

Criminalise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was criminalising We were criminalising
You were criminalising You were criminalising
He/She/It was criminalising They were criminalising

Criminalise in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had criminalised We had criminalised You had criminalised He/She/It had criminalised They had criminalised

Criminalise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been criminalising We had been criminalising
You had been criminalising
He/She/It had been criminalising They had been criminalising

Criminalise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will criminalise
You will criminalise
He/She/It will criminalise
They will criminalise

Criminalise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be criminalising
You will be criminalising
He/She/It will be criminalising
They will be criminalising

Criminalise in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have criminalised
You will have criminalised
He/She/It will have criminalised
They will have criminalised

Criminalise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been criminalising
You will have been criminalising
He/She/It will have been criminalising
They will have been criminalising
